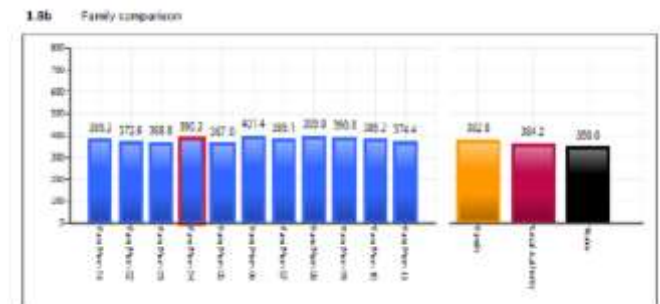
Golyga hyn bydd y llywodraeth yn edrych ar y 9 canlyniad TGAU gorau gan bob disgybl. Rhoddir pwyntiau am raddau fel a ganlyn:

A* - 58 pwynt	A - 52 pwynt
B - 48 pwynt	C - 42 pwynt
D - 36 pwynt	E - 28 pwynt
F - 22 pwynt	G - 16 pwynt

O'r naw pwnc byddant yn mesur iaith neu Lenyddiaeth Gymraeg, iaith neu Lenyddiaeth Saesneg, Mathemateg neu Rifedd; bydd Cymhwyster Bagloriaeth Cymru yn cyfrif fel 2 ac wedyn ychwanegir unrhyw 4 pwnc arall.

Pe byddai disgybl yn cael 9 x A* byddai ganddo sgôr o 522, neu pe byddai'n ennill 9 x C byddai ganddo sgôr o 378. Bydd y llywodraeth wedyn yn cyfrifo cyfartaledd yr ysgol ac yn ein gosod mewn band lliw ar gyfer categorieddïo'r ysgol. Credaf fod y system newydd yn well ac yn rhoi cyfle i bob disgybl sy'n gwneud cynnydd i gyfranu at sgôr yr ysgol yn hytrach na phawb oedd wedi cyrraedd gradd C neu well yn yr hen system.

Eleni roedd Sgôr Cyfartalog yr ysgol yn 390.2 sydd yn gryf iawn wrth gymharu gyda sgôr ysgolion tebyg sydd yn yr un Teulu â ni. Mae unarddeg o ysgolion yn ein Teulu gyda Bro Hyddgen yn safle 4 (sef y bedwaredd ysgol gyda'r mwyaf o her o ran plant yn derbyn cinio am ddim a thlodi). Fel y gwelwch o'r tabl isod mae'r ysgol yn gwneud yn well na chyfartaledd y Teulu, Powys a Chymru.

Cinderella Rockerfella Christmas Show

The highlight of the term for many on the primary campus has been performing the **Cinderella Rockerfella** show. This performance has been an exceptional opportunity for the children to develop important skills such as cooperation, communication and perseverance. I would like to express my gratitude to the team of staff who have given of their time to ensure that this is a show to remember.

Changes to the Method of Measuring Standards

During this term Welsh Government have decided to make significant changes to the way school standards are measured. To date, the Level 2 Indicator, including attainment in Maths/Numeracy along with either English or Welsh First Language were used as the key measurements; by 2018 Welsh Government intends to measure school attainment through a Capped Points Score system.

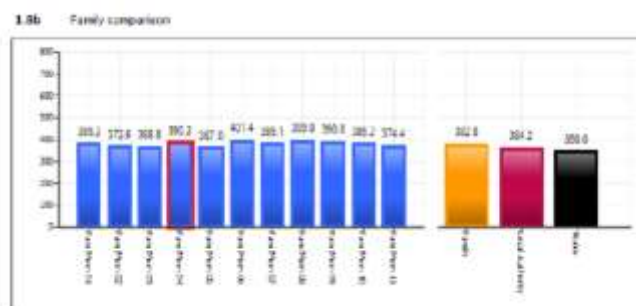
This means that the government will look each pupil's best 9 GCSE results. Grades are awarded the following points:

A* - 58 points	A - 52 points
B - 48 points	C - 42 points
D - 36 points	E - 28 points
F - 22 points	G - 16 points

To make up the nine subjects, they will measure Welsh Language or Literature, English Language or Literature, Maths or Numeracy; the Welsh Baccalaureate qualification will count as 2 qualifications and then another 4 subjects will be added.

If a pupil were to achieve 9 x A* he/she would score 522; if a pupil were to achieve 9 x C he/she would score 378. The government will then work out the average point score for the school and then place the school in one of four colour bands in order to categorise the school. I believe this system is better as it gives every pupil who makes progress the opportunity to contribute towards the school's score, unlike the old system which only took into account those pupils who had achieved a C grade or above.

This year the school's average point score was 390.2 which is very strong when compared with similar schools which are placed in the same Family of schools as us. There are 11 schools in the same Family as us with Bro Hyddgen placed in the 4th position (which means that we are the fourth school with the greatest amount of challenge taking into consideration how many pupils receive free school meals and pupil deprivation). As you see from the table below the school's average point score is higher than the Family's average point score, also Powys and Wales.



I look forward to welcoming everyone back in January after a well-deserved break when I hope you all have plenty of opportunity to enjoy, relax and rest over the holidays. School will reopen to children on Tuesday 9 January 2018.

Until then, I wish you all a very happy Christmas and a Happy New Year.

Cost Hysbysiad Cosb

Os bydd angen hysbysiad, bydd y rhiant yn cael rhybudd o 15 diwrnod i roi unrhyw dystiolaeth y dymuna ei chyflwyno i'r ysgol i ddadlau pam na ddylai'r hysbysiad gael ei roi. Mater i'r ysgol fydd penderfynu a ddylai'r dystiolaeth gael ei derbyn. Ni fydd y cyfnod rhybudd o 15 diwrnod yn berthnasol i absenoldeb heb awdurdod sy'n gysylltiedig â gwyliau.

Nid oes cyfyngiadau ar nifer y rhybuddion ffurfiol y gellir eu rhoi.

Os nad yw eich plentyn yn yr ysgol, yna siaradwch â'r ysgol cyn gynted â phosibl ar ddiwrnod cyntaf ei absenoldeb. Disgwylir i'ch plentyn fod yn yr ysgol am 190 diwrnod yn ystod blwyddyn academaidd gyda 175 o ddyddiau i ffwrdd oherwydd penwythnosau a gwyliau ysgol.

Presenoldeb / Attendance

The Welsh Government have instructed all local authorities to implement Penalty Charge Notices under the Welsh Government Education (Penalty Notice) (Wales) Regulations 2013. The ERW consortium believe that any absence from school, for **whatever reason, is detrimental to a child's long term life opportunities**, so should be avoided if at all possible.

A Penalty Charge Notice is issued as an alternative to prosecution. The aim of which is to promote the improvement in attendance at school of the child.

Appealing against a Penalty Charge Notice.

There is no statutory right of appeal against a Penalty Charge Notice under the Regulations, though where a parent contests the issuing of a Penalty Charge Notice they can contact the Education Welfare Service.

Who will receive a Penalty Notice?

A Penalty Charge Notice will be issued to each parent, in respect of each child who is absent from school without good reason. Section 576 of the Education Act 1996 defines a **'parent' to include persons who are not parents but who have parental responsibility or care of the child**

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD ATTEND SCHOOL EVERY DAY

100% attendance	0 days learning missed	Best chance of success!
95% attendance	2 weeks of learning missed	Poor attendance will impact on learning.
90% attendance	4 weeks of learning missed	
85% attendance	5 ½ weeks of learning missed	Very poor attendance has a significant impact on learning. You are at risk of prosecution.
80% attendance	At least 7 ½ weeks of learning missed.	

A Penalty Charge Notice may be issued:

When a pupil has a minimum of 10 sessions or five school days lost due to unauthorised absences during the current term that brings the pupils' overall attendance at school below 90% in the school year to date.

10 sessions, or 5 school days, are lost due to holidays in term-time if the absence takes the pupils school attendance to below 90% in the current school year to date.

10 sessions of persistent lateness after the register has closed in a term bringing the pupils school attendance to below 90% in the current school year to date.

The cost of a Penalty Charge Notice.

If a notice is required the parent will have a warning of 15 days to provide any evidence they may wish to present to the school to argue why the notice should not be issued. It will be for the school to determine if the evidence is accepted. There is no limit to the number of formal warnings that can be issued.

If the school attendance of the child does not improve then the penalty will be:

The Penalty Charge Notice is for the amount of £120 though this will be subject to a discounted amount £60 should this amount be paid within 42 days.

If the Penalty Charge Notice is not paid at all then the Local Authority (LA) will consider prosecution for the original offence, which is **'failure to ensure regular attendance at school'** under sections 444 (1) or 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996.

Support with School Attendance.

Please remember that if there are reasons why your child is missing school then keep the school informed.

If your child is off school then speak to the school as early as possible on the first day of their absence.

Your child is expected to be in school for 190 days an academic year with 175 days off due to weekends and school holidays.

Does dim dwywaith bod y sioe yn wledd i'r llygad ac i'r glust. 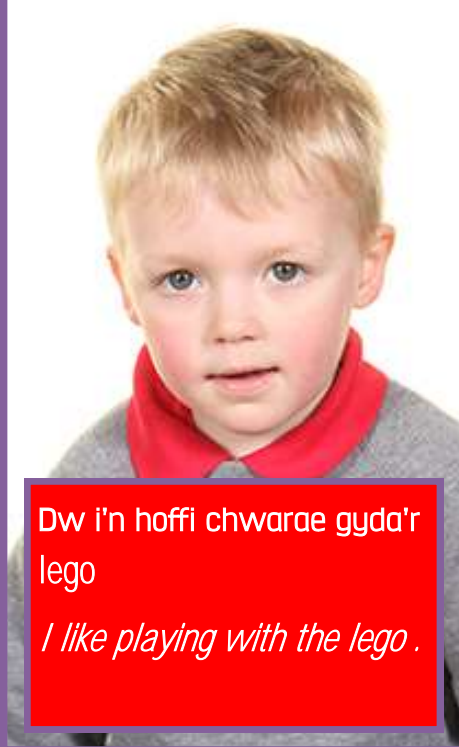

All of last year's year 13 students who applied for a place at university received offers from institutions across the UK and we wish all of them every success for the future.

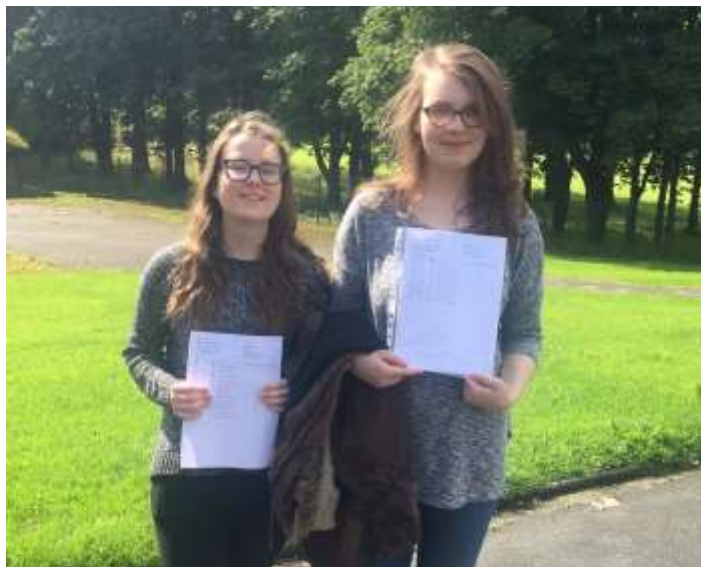

Following the planting of daffodil and crocus bulbs, the pupils will keep a record of the weather in the coming months by measuring the daily temperature and rainfall, and will monitor when the flowers open in the spring. Data from schools across Wales will be collated and analysed to identify patterns on how weather effects nature.

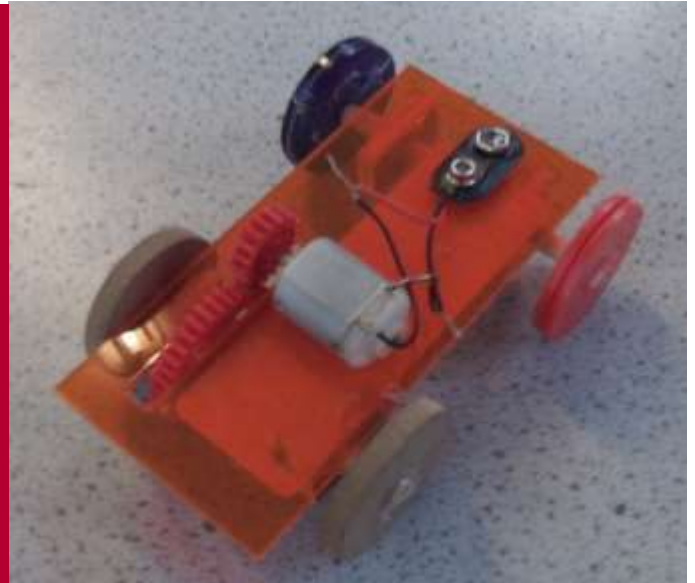

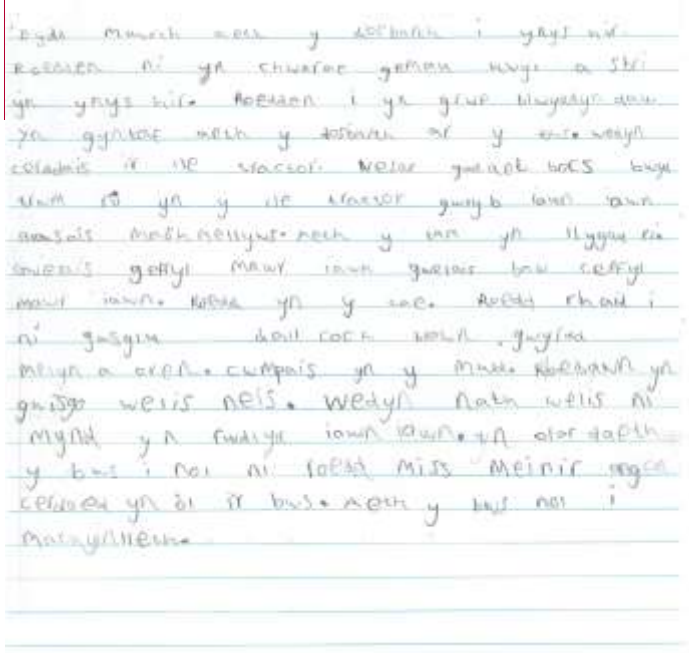

A group of 11 AS Geography Pupils from Mrs Eirian Davies' Year 12 Geography class ventured to Pembrokeshire at the beginning of December, with Mr Peter Kenny as our trusted minibus driver. We drove for around 3 hours before reaching Milford Haven, our first destination. We studied areas of Milford Haven to answer the questions "How and why has the economy changed?" We then made our way to our home for the weekend, Orierton Fieldwork centre. We enjoyed a hearty supper before spending some more time studying data collection techniques. Even though this involved evening sessions, the pupils worked exceptionally hard, and were a credit to themselves and their school throughout the weekend.

Saturday saw us venturing out early to study coastal processes. We visited a number of locations including Saundersfoot, Amroth and other beaches in Pembrokeshire. We took pictures, collected data on ipads using Apps, and measured the dimensions of sediment used as coastal defences using Hudson's equation to assess their effectiveness. A very busy day!

Once again on Sunday we faced an early start (with everybody getting upon time) and we travelled to Stackpole Quay, with again more opportunities to study the stunning coastline there. Today's lesson was focussed on using skitch, and assessing the likelihood of mass movement due to geology type. We were astounded by the beauty of Barafundle Bay, and finished our visit by climbing down to visit one of Wales' best beaches.
