

I like to thank all the staff for their tireless work during the last year, you all deserve to have a restful Christmas.



4 Presenoldeb / Attendance

Gwyliau / Absenoldeb yn Ystod y Tymor.

Rydym yn awyddus i weld pob plentyn yng Nghymru'n llwyddo. Gan hynny mae'n bwysig bod rhieni'n gwneud eu gorau glas i helpu disgyblion i ddod i'r ysgol am y 190 diwrnod llawn mewn blwyddyn academaidd, yn ôl Rheoliadau Addysg (Y Diwrnod Ysgol a'r Flwyddyn Ysgol) (Diwygiad) 2006.

O dan y Ddeddf Addysg (1996), cyfrifoldeb y rhiant neu'r gofalwr yw sicrhau bod eu mab neu eu merch yn mynychu'r ysgol. Mae presenoldeb rheolaidd yn hanfodol bwysig ac mae colli'r ysgol yn gallu cael effaith fawr ar gyflawniad dros flwyddyn fel mae'r grid isod yn ei ddangos:

Gobeithio y byddwch chi'n gallu cefnogi'r polisi hwn a threfnu gwyliau y tu allan i amser tymor. Mae'r ysgol ar gau am 175 diwrnod mewn blwyddyn os ydych chi'n cyfrif penwythnosau a gwyliau ysgol. Bydd hyn yn ein helpu i sicrhau bod eich plentyn yn llwyddo yn yr ysgol.

Serch hyn, os bydd amgylchiadau'n codi sy'n golygu bod rhaid i chi gymryd gwyliau yn ystod y tymor, rydym yn gofyn i chi lenwi'r ffurflen ar ochr arall y llythyr hwn a'i hanfon yn ôl i'r ysgol at sylw'r pennaeth.

Gwneud Cais am Wyliau

Os ydych chi'n dymuno mynd â'ch plentyn neu'ch plant ar wyliau yn ystod amser tymor rhaid i chi lenwi'r ffurflen **Cais am Wyliau** a geir o'r swyddfa, o leiaf 28 diwrnod cyn mynd i ffwrdd. Wedyn bydd y Pennaeth / Pennaeth Cynorthwyol yn ystyried eich cais.

Mae Rheoliadau Addysg (Cofrestru Disgyblion) (Cymru) 2010 yn rhoi grym dewisol i benaethiaid i adael i deulu gymryd gwyliau yn ystod amser tymor lle mae rhieni'n gofyn caniatâd. Ar wahân i amgylchiadau arbennig, ni chaniateir mwy na deg diwrnod o wyliau. Yn yr ysgol hon byddwn yn ystyried yr agweddau canlynol cyn penderfynu caniatâu gwyliau yn ystod amser tymor.

- Ffigyrau presenoldeb ar gyfer y flwyddyn flaenorol. (Byddwn yn disgwyl i bresenoldeb fod yn uwch na 90 y cant.)
- Ymddygiad ac agwedd tuag at fywyd ysgol.
- Nad yw'r gwyliau'n torri ar draws cyfnodau dysgu pwysig rydym wedi tynnu'ch sylw atyn nhw (fel asesiadau ddiwedd y flwyddyn sy'n digwydd ym mis Mai bob blwyddyn).
- Eich bod yn llenwi'r ffurflen hon yn gywir a chyflwyno cais 28 diwrnod cyn y gwyliau.

Y Pennaeth yn unig sydd biau'r dewis i ganiatâu gwyliau fel y bydd yn gweld yn dda.

Byddwn yn gwneud cais i roi Hysbysiad Cosb Benodedig os byddwn yn cofnodi pum diwrnod neu fwy (deg sesiwn) o 'absenoldeb heb awdurdod' a bod presenoldeb o dan 90 y cant ar gyfer y flwyddyn academaidd hyd yn hyn.

Byddwn yn anfon bonyn caniatâu / gwrthod caniatâu atoch chi o fewn saith diwrnod ar ôl i ni dderbyn eich cais



Presenoldeb / Attendance

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Holidays / Absence during term time.

In Wales we want all of our pupils to achieve success, so it is important that parents do their best to support pupils in attending school for the full 190 days in an academic year, as stated in the Education (School Day and School Year) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

Under the Education Act (1996), it is the responsibility of the parent or carer to ensure that their son/daughter attend school. Regular school attendance is vital and missing school can have a significant impact on achievement over a one year period as illustrated below:

95-100%	Best chance of success	Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.
90-95% attendance	At least 2 weeks of learning missed	Satisfactory. Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.
85-90% attendance	At least 4 weeks of learning missed	Your child may be at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work.
80-85% attendance	At least 5 ½ weeks of learning missed	Your child's poor attendance has a significant impact on learning.
Below 80% attendance	At least 7½ weeks of learning missed	Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education. You are at risk of prosecution.

We hope that you can support this policy and arrange your holidays around the existing 175 days the schools are closed through weekends and school holidays and help us support your child in achieving success in school.

If, however, there are circumstances that mean you have to take a holiday during term time, we ask that you fill in the form on the reverse of this letter and return to school for the attention of the head teacher.

Holiday Requests

*If you wish to take your child/ren on a holiday during term time, a **Holiday Request** form must be completed at least 28 days before the date of the absence so that the request can be considered for authorisation.*

The Pupil Registration (Wales) Regulations 2010 provide head teachers with a discretionary power to authorise leave for a family holiday during term time where parents seek permission. Save in exceptional circumstances, no more than 10 days leave should be granted for this purpose. The procedure at this school is that all the factors noted below will be taken into consideration before a decision is made as to whether to authorise any periods of holiday requested during term time.

- Attendance figures for the last year. (We would expect attendance to be above 90%.)
- Behaviour and attitude to school life.
- That the holiday does not impact on any key periods of learning identified and highlighted by the school (such as the end of year pupil assessments carried out during the month of May each year).
- That this form has been completed correctly and the request has been made 28 days before the holiday.

Please therefore remember that holidays can only be authorised at the Head Teacher's discretion.

It should also be noted that an application for a 'Fixed Penalty Notice' will be considered if there are 5 or more days (10 sessions) of 'unauthorised absence' recorded, in addition to the attendance level being below 90% for the school year to date.

An authorised / unauthorised slip will be sent back to you within 7 days of submitting this request.

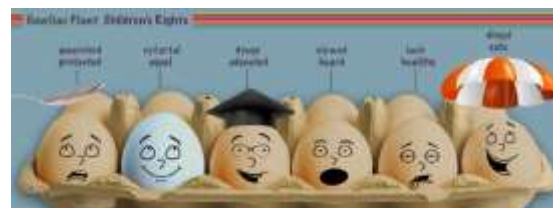

We have discussed many topics; the Powys Youth Forum; starting an Aelwyd yr Urdd for Years 10 and above; raising money for the Air Ambulance charity; discussing the Stonewall project to promote awareness of their work supporting LGBT issues; school uniform; use of mobile phones and we have received a presentation from a member of staff about the Snowdonia National Park Authority and its work.

We as head pupils shall be planning over the Christmas period, events to be held in the school hall to raise money for the Air ambulance charity, and perhaps charity cake stalls during the year. We will also be aiming over forthcoming months to raise money for new equipment for the school, such as ICT equipment.

During this term, we have held Aelwyd evenings in the school and are eager to encourage students from Years 10 and above to be present as they're a brilliant way for older students in different years to get to know each other and enjoy activities provided by the Urdd. Also, we are aiming to plan a trip to the ice rink in Aberystwyth as part of one of these sessions as an icebreaker for anyone interested in attending.

Regarding the Stonewall Project, an assembly about the organisation has been presented to the whole school at the beginning of December in order to raise awareness about different aspects of the LGBT community and to make it clear that the school and its staff are completely supportive and always around if any individual has anything they'd like to discuss.

In response to the issue of some students not always wearing the correct uniform, we had a meeting in which we discussed the importance of school uniform and agreed that it is important to wear the correct uniform to ensure we all appear smart and equal in the school.

Finally was the topic of mobile phone use in school: we believe that the school is very generous to allow the use of mobile phones within school grounds as many schools in the area have decided against it. In order for it to remain this way, mobile phones should only be used outside of lessons unless a teacher gives permission to use them for work purposes. This is crucial to enhance our learning and keep the school as a safe, happy place. We appreciate that we're given guidance about the positive uses of mobile phones which will be beneficial for us later in life.



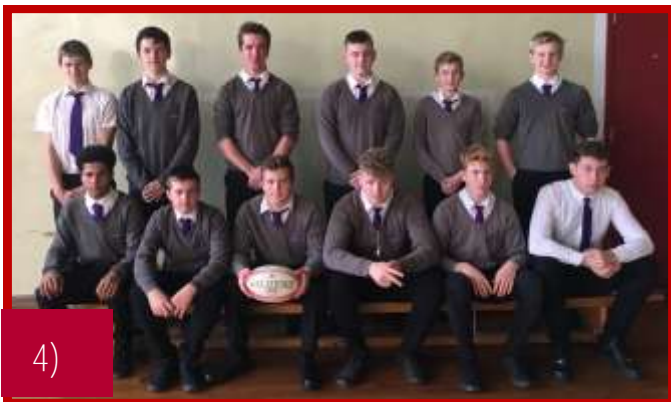

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A busy and successful term once again for the Physical Education department with participation rates excelling in a number of sports. It has been very pleasing to note that 78% of the boys in KS3 and KS4 have represented the school on at least one occasion. With cross country, basketball, athletics and badminton all to come after Christmas, there is still plenty of opportunity for pupils to participate in the extra-curricular programme for all abilities and ages.

Up until half term the boys, in years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 6th form teams competed in the local football and rugby tournaments. (Picture 1) Years 8 and 10 football teams began the school's season by travelling to Llanidloes High school competing in a three way tournament with Newtown. The year 8 team lost narrowly in the dying moments to Llanidloes 1-0 and drew 2-2 with Newtown. After going ahead, the year 10 team lost 3-2 to Llanidloes and 9-0 to an impressive Newtown team. (Picture 2+3). The following week we welcomed Llanfair Caereinion to the school in a Welsh Cup Tie: a school with a proud record in football. Eager to make up for the previous week, the Year 9 team put in a fantastic performance in all areas with a winning score of 7-1. The year 7 team were held to a goalless draw and had to decide the match on penalties. The accuracy of the shooting was of high quality however, Bro Hyddgen won 3-1 and therefore both teams qualify for the next round.

(Picture 4+5) The following week we began our rugby season with years 9 and 11 travelling to Bro Idris, Dolgellau. The boys were in high spirits and showed perseverance throughout the game. The year 11 boys lost 26-19 with the year 9 team winning 42-26 despite trailing the majority of the game. A fantastic effort especially from the year 9 team for their 'never say die' attitude. (Picture 6+7) The following day, two teams of year 7 pupils returned to Dolgellau to compete in a rugby festival against Dolgellau, Moelwyn-Blaenau Ffestiniog and three teams from Berwyn- Bala. Being their first taste of secondary school rugby, the boys were excited yet slightly anxious. Any anxiety however quickly disappeared in their first game with both teams showing great skills in both attack and defence. Bro Hyddgen 1 went on to beat Bro Idris whilst putting in excellent performances losing narrowly to Berwyn and Molwyn. Bro Hyddgen 2 went a step further and were undefeated in all 5 games. Their offloading and powerful, evasive running created the platform for some excellent tries throughout the day.

Rugby continued the week after with our years 9 and 11 playing against Ysgol Y Berwyn. Year 11 were eager to make up for their disappointing result the previous week. Despite Y Berwyn bringing a strong and skilful team, the year 11 team put in the performance of their school career losing agonisingly by one point in the final play 27-26. An effort, which was off the scale, finishing with only 11 players on the pitch. The year 9 team also lost, but again showed their perseverance playing right until the final whistle to score two tries. (Picture 8+9 and 10). The following day two-mixed year 7 and one Year 8 team travelled to Newtown to play in a North Powys Rugby festival against Llanidloes, Newtown and John Beddoes. The year 7 team were looking to carry on from their success the previous week whilst Year 8 were hoping to start their season with success. All three teams played exceptionally with a number of superb individual performances and strong

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running and tackling, exceptional offloading and good inter play to score tries. The teams won the majority of games once again. A fantastic experience for all.

(Picture 11) The first game of the season for the U13 girls was also played on the same day against Newtown High School. After a number of impressive training sessions the girls were in high spirits and played a very competitive and enjoyable game.

The week after began with our Year 8 team travelling to Dolgellau to participate in a rugby festival against Ardudwy, Y Berwyn and Bro Idris. The afternoon was another great success with a number leading by example to win our games against Ardudwy and Bro Idris to set up a final against Y Berwyn. It was not to be our day however losing to a very skilful and strong side (Picture 12). A few days later the school welcomed Ardudwy's years 9 and 11 teams for the final round of the Eryri League. Both teams were eager to finish their half term with strong performances. Year 9 recorded a 52-7 victory whilst the year 11 team lost 35-21.

The final week before the half term break saw our Year 7 team compete in the Powys football semi-final against Llanfyllin. After a good performance against Llanfair Caereinion, the pupils were full of confidence going into the game. Despite trailing twice in the game, their determination and attitude to never give up until the final whistle saw them draw 2-2. The game was decided on penalties. All pupils were willing to volunteer to help their team win the match. As a result, the team won the penalty shoot-out 5-4 and as a result progressed to the Powys final (Picture 13). To end the half term, our 6th form 7's Rugby team travelled to Dolgellau to play in a cross field festival. With priority at 6th form beginning to be focused towards the academic side the boys were looking forward to play against Coleg Meirion Dwyfor, Y Berwyn and Menai Bridge (picture 14).

After half term the school football teams were once again back in action where years 7, 8 and 9 travelled to Newtown FC to compete in the annual North Powys tournament. Bro Hyddgen have done well in recent years with the Year 8 team winning the previous year. All years put in a fantastic effort with the year 9 team narrowly missing out on a win in the final moments of the final game. (picture 15, 16 + 17).

The 6th form team turned their attention from the rugby to the football team in the second week taking on Welshpool HS in the Powys Cup. Despite a slow start against a team, who would eventually go on to win, the team put on a good second half performance eventually losing 3-1. The following week, the year 9 football team were up against Welshpool once again, this time in their semi-final game. Having lost to Welshpool in their Year 7 final, the boys were eager for revenge. It was not to be their day as Welshpool scored with almost the last kick of the game losing agonisingly 2-1. A fantastic effort by the year considering only 15 boys were available to play that day. (picture 18+19).

The following week began with a successful ski trip meeting where 41 pupils and 5 members of staff will travel to Obertauern, Austria in the Easter holidays. After a successful 2017 trip to Zellamsee in 2017, everyone is excited and looking forward to the trip. On the Thursday the year 7 team travelled to John Beddoes in their Year 7 Powys football game. Another fantastic achievement by the school teams in reaching the final against a much bigger school. Also, Isaac and Euros competed in the Abersytwyth 10k race on the same week scoring respectable times of 37 and 42 minutes. (Picture 20,21,22). Next week out 6th form Rugby team will be travelling to Coleg Meirion Dwyfor for their Eryri Cup match whilst our indoor athletics teams travel to Llanfari Caereinion.

A report from Hanna on her trip to Patagonia with the Urdd



Dros flwyddyn yn ôl mi gefais y gyfle i fynd am gyfweiliad i wersyll yr Urdd Glanllyn er mwyn cesio am le ar daith Yr Urdd i Batagonia 2018. Roeddwn yn ffodus iawn i gael fy newis allan o dros 200 o bobl ifanc ar draws Cymru i fod yn un o'r 25 i fynychu'r daith. Ar ôl trip o amgylch yr ardal hanesyddol yma roedd yn amser i ni greu cyngerdd ar gyfer y bobl leol, roedd yn hynod o emosiynol gweld hen bobl yr ardal oedd hefo gymaint o angerdd am yr iaith Gymraeg, yn wir roedd yna lawer o ddagrau pan yn canu'r anthem genedlaethol. Ymlaen a ni yn hwyrach y noson hono i Gapel Bryn Crwn, un o nosweithau gorau'r holl daith. Geography Department

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Pupils following the GCSE Geography course have been very busy this term, participating in fieldwork visits and completing a portfolio of their work.

To begin with, on Wednesday 19th of September, all the GCSE Geography pupils visited Aberystwyth. The purpose of this visit was to investigate any effects that the new Tesco and M&S development is having on the town's high street. It was a good day and the weather, on the whole, was favourable, with one shower a great excuse for many to shelter from the rain and have lunch in KFC!

The pupils were divided into two groups to complete the second fieldwork focusing on the Afon Ddyfi, many would argue that this is the main physical feature on the landscape in this area. The pupils followed the river's course from the upper course in Cwm Cywarch to the estuary in Aberdyfi. The first group went out to the field on the 4th of October, the weather was good. However, the second group weren't so lucky on the 11th of October, this is a summary of the second day written by some of the pupils.

On Thursday 11th of October our class went on a geography fieldtrip, visiting different sites along the river to see how the river changes from the source to the estuary. The first site was Cwm Cywarch, here the landscape was steep with rugged mountains and cliffs. The river at this site was very narrow and shallow, the river flowed down the rocky terrain forming interlocking spurs. Unfortunately, it started to rain and some of us were scared in case we fell on the way down!

The landscape at the second site was very different to the rugged mountains and nasty weather at the first site. The mountains, that were the main feature on the land space in Cwm Cywarch, were now in the background. We could now see a floodplain near the river, as the afon Cleifion and the afon Ddyfi join forming a confluence. A river cliff was also an apparent feature along the river bank near Mallwyd.

We moved onto the third site, Cwmlinau, here we saw a meander. During our lessons in class, we have learnt how a meander forms, it was great to see this landform for real. We saw how the river erodes the land and deposits its load to create this landform. There was clear evidence that the river was eroding the land because the farmer's fens had fallen over the cliff edge!

When we arrived at Aberdyfi, our fourth site it was raining heavily, we couldn't even see the estuary! But we had time for some ice cream. It was quite a shock to see some school pupils canoeing in the rain. A big thank you to Miss Iona Thomas and Mr Peter Kenny for taking us on a journey along afon Ddyfi.
