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Dear parent/guardian,

The school is taking this opportunity to update its data handling processes and statements on how it collects, stores and processes information about your child. The Welsh Government have set targets for schools to accredit themselves to the Safe Wales 360 framework. As part of this process we have reviewed how we use internal and external information and we need to make it clear how this information is kept and processed in more detail than what are currently in the school prospectus and secondary campus contact books.

In addition to what we have disclosed in pupils contact books and consent forms at the start of the school year on how we use and process information, we need to update this information as Powys would like us to use of the Welsh Government's e-learning system called "hwb". As this is in addition to what has already been disclosed to you, we have a statutory duty under the data protection act to inform you of this addition. The hwb portal can benefit many schools with a host of extra services free to use for schools to help teachers share ideas and resources. Some of these services are provided by external 3rd parties which are external to the Welsh Government but securely authenticated and controlled by the Welsh Governments login portal and comply with all Local Authority and Welsh Government data handling policy's including the Data Protection Act.

Pupils are already using Hwb's tools as part of their learning. At the moment they are using it to enhance their learning therefore parental consent is not needed. The Welsh Government has now asked schools to further the use of these tools not only to teach pupils but to help to moderate and assess pupils work in order to help schools standardise levels online. Due to staff using this tool as part of the assessment process we have a statutory duty to ensure you are aware of this and we have updated this along with the other types of services we use to process information on the attached sheet. This information is authenticated using the Hwb platform and accessed only by teachers and schools officers in Powys and relevant agencies. All data is kept securely and will be disposed of in accordance of the Data Protection Act once the work is moderated and standardise using the online assessment tools. In the attached sheet there is more information on how our school uses information.

Attached to this letter there is a pamphlet explaining how the school uses the information it collects, stores, processes and then deletes information in compliance with the Data Protection Act after your child leaves the school.

Shortly as part of the process of gaining this accreditation there will be an open evening to display the different resources and systems the school has to offer to help your child education. This includes online based software including Purple Mash in the primary and Office 365 which enables all pupils to access Microsoft products free from home and continue with their learning. More information about this event will be sent out after Easter.

Until then, if you could read the pamphlet and any further information or questions that you may have can be raised in the ICT open evening. If you have any urgent questions or concerns please don't hesitate to get in touch with the school.

One of the requirements of the accreditation is to ensure that each parent has received this document. If you could please sign and return this slip to the school I would be most grateful.
