Sut I ddefnyddio Home Access Plus+

It is now possible for you to see your school computer files at home. Ysgol Bro Ddyfi is the only school in Mid and North Wales that offers this service. It is possible for all pupils to access their files from home.

1. Yn gyntaf mae angen i chi fynd ar wefan Ysgol Bro Ddyfi. www.broddyfi.co.uk. Yna mae angen gwasgu botwm y linc sydd ar ochr dde'r sgrin.

First you need to go to the school website www.broddyfi.co.uk and click on the blue link on the right hand side. See the picture on the right.



2. Bydd blwch nawr yn ymddangos ar y sgrin fel yr un ar y chwith. Mi fydd angen i chi lenwi'r bylchau gan gyflwyno eich enw a chyfrinair eich cyfrif ysgol a gwasgu 'ok'.

Next a box will appear on the screen like the one on the left. You will need to fill in the form with your school account details and click ok.

3. Nawr mae'n bosib i chi glicio ar **Browse My School Computer** lle bydd hi'n bosib i chi weld eich ffolderi a'ch ffeiliau. Yno cewch dewis rhwng eich ffolder chi, y ffolder **Curriculum Pool** neu ffolder y **shared drive**.

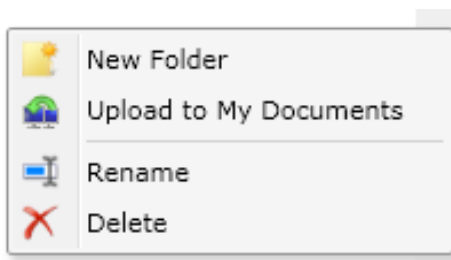

Yn 2012, mae disgyblion blwyddyn 11 Ysgol Bro Ddyfi wedi creu cryn argraff gan sicrhau'r canlyniadau TGAU gorau erioed yn hanes yr ysgol. Dros y blynyddoedd diwethaf, mae cynnydd graddol wedi bod yn y canlyniadau TGAU, a gwelwyd cryn gynnydd y llynedd yn nifer y graddau A*-A a enillwyd.

Mae Mr Dafydd Jones, y Pennaeth yn hynod o hapus i longyfarch y disgyblion ar ennill 87% o 5 gradd A*-C eleni (cynnydd o 20% ar ganlyniadau'r flwyddyn flaenorol). **"Mae'r flwyddyn yn ei chyfanrwydd wedi cael canlyniadau arbennig ac rwy'n falch iawn i weld yr holl ddisgyblion yn cyflawni i'w potensial. Mae'r disgyblion wedi gweithio'n galed iawn dros y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf i sicrhau'r canlyniadau penigamp yma. Hoffwn hefyd dalu teyrnged i ansawdd gwaith yr holl staff sydd wedi gweithio'n ddiflino gyda'r disgyblion yma; y rhodd mwyaf gwerthfawr gall unrhyw athro ei roi i ddisgybl yn Ysgol Bro Ddyfi yw ei amser, ac mae athrawon yr ysgol yn hynod o hael wrth rannu o'u hamser. Yn ogystal, mae rhieni wedi bod yn greiddiol i'r llwyddiant a brofwyd ar yr achlysur hwn trwy gefnogi'r cyfundrefnau mentora a gyflwynwyd dros y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf. Bydd mwyafrif helaeth y myfyrwyr o'r flwyddyn hon yn dychwelyd i Ysgol Bro Ddyfi i astudio Safon Uwch a chyr-siau galwedigaethol cyfatebol, a byddant yn anelu i sicrhau llwyddiant pellach ymhen dwy flynedd. Mae'r ysgol hefyd yn falch iawn i allu croesawu nifer arwyddocaol o fyfyrwyr newydd i'r Chweched Dosbarth ym mis Medi o ardaloedd eraill tu hwnt i ddalgylch yr ysgol"**

Year 11 pupils at Ysgol Bro Ddyfi have created their own piece of history this week by achieving the highest GCSE results ever seen at the school. Over recent years, there has been a gradual upward trend in the results gained, and last year showed a marked improvement in the number of A-A grades achieved.*

Mr Dafydd Jones, the Headteacher is thrilled this year to

be congratulating pupils on achieving a record-breaking 85% 5 A-C grades at GCSE (a 20% increase on the results of the previous year). "The cohort as a whole produced excellent results and I'm very proud to see the pupils fulfilling their potential. The pupils have worked very hard over the past two years towards achieving these outstanding results. I would like to pay tribute to the quality of work of all the staff who have worked tirelessly to produce these outcomes; the most valuable gift any teacher can give a pupil at Ysgol Bro Ddyfi is their own time and this is given in abundance at the school. Parents have also been central to the success achieved on this occasion by supporting mentoring initiatives which have been introduced over the past two years. The vast majority of the students from this cohort will now be returning to Ysgol Bro Ddyfi to study A levels and equivalent vocational courses, and will be aiming to achieve further success in two years' time. The school is also very pleased to be welcoming a significant number of new students to the Sixth Form in September from other areas beyond the school's catchment area".*

Literacy Apps

Mae llawer iawn o ddisgyblion bellach gyda ffonau symudol a thabledi digidol. Mae'r disgyblion sydd gyda ipod Touch, ipad, ffonau HTC a ffonau eraill sy'n rhedeg systemau Android a thabledi gyda mynediad i 'Apps' sy'n gwneud datblygu sgiliau llythrenedd a rhifedd yn hwyl, ac yn brofiad llwyddiannus! Fel ysgol, rydym yn annog disgyblion i ddefnyddio'r Apps hyn ar eu ffonau a'u tabledi ac i dreulio ychydig o amser yn gyson yn ystod y gwyliau (a thymor yr ysgol) yn ymarfer a datblygu eu sgiliau. Dyma gasgliad o Apps (rhaid rhad ac am ddim, a rhai sy'n rhaid talu amdanynt) yr awgrymir fel rhai da i'w defnyddio, er mae miloedd ar gael ar y wê, ac mae rhai newydd yn cael eu cyhoeddi'n gyson, felly mae'n werth edrych ar **itunes** a **Google Play** i weld beth sydd ar gael yn y meysydd hyn yn achlysurol.

Many pupils now have access to mobile phones and digital tablets. The pupils who have access to an ipod Touch, ipad, iphone, HTC phones and other Android phones and tablets also have access to Apps which make developing Literacy and Numeracy skills a fun and successful learning experience.

As a school, we are encouraging our pupils to put some of these Apps on their phones and tablets and to spend some time using them on a regular basis. The forthcoming holidays are an excellent opportunity to practice and develop these skills.

*Below are some free Apps and some which have to be paid for. Although these Apps are recommended by the school, there are also thousands of other Apps available on the internet, and new Apps are published all the time, therefore it is worth visiting **itunes** or **Google Play** from time to time to see what is available.*

On Friday 23rd of November a group of pupils from the ICT club went to Aberystwyth University for a lecture on Artificial Intelligence and Robotics which was arranged by the Computer Science Department which hosted the "show and tell" evening. This lecture was very successful in showcasing some of the areas which the club has been working on, such as programming and plans for the future development of programming in the school.

The ICT club will be using these new skills along with a grant from the County Council to create resources on how to program and host a website, which will be the hub of a learning community for the Machynlleth area, with the aim of getting more secondary and primary pupils into programming.

With this project the club will be able to publish their work online and help others to create apps and use the new "Raspberry Pi" computer which runs on Unix.

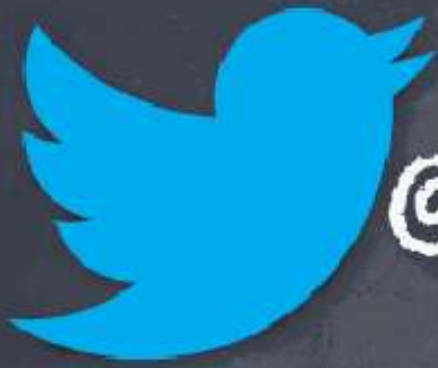

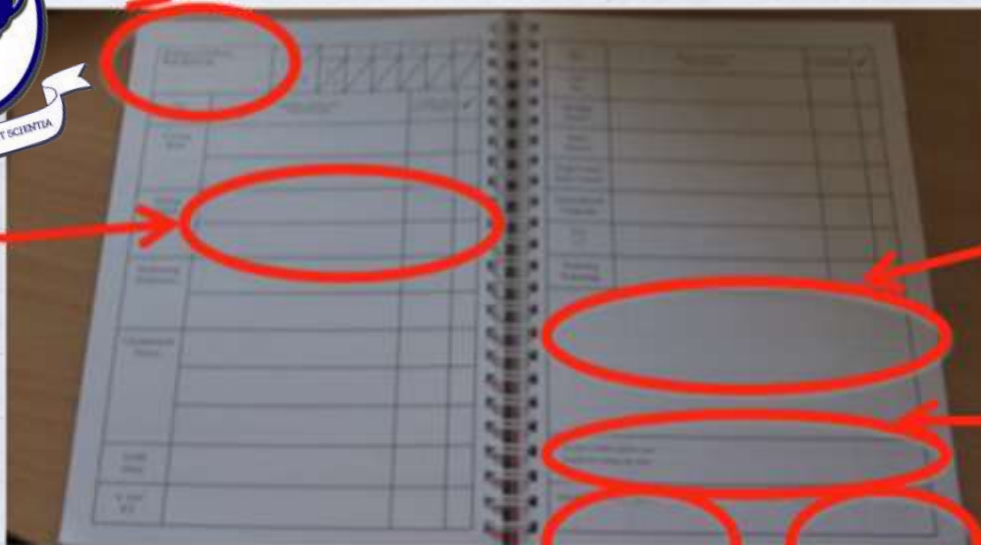

Home Work In Ysgol Bro Ddyfi

At Ysgol Bro Ddyfi in Key Stage 3, every subject aims to set 4 pieces of homework in Term 1 and again in Term 2. As the core subjects receive more lessons, the number way well be higher in these, and in the non-core subjects, it may be slightly less.



There are three main types of homework:

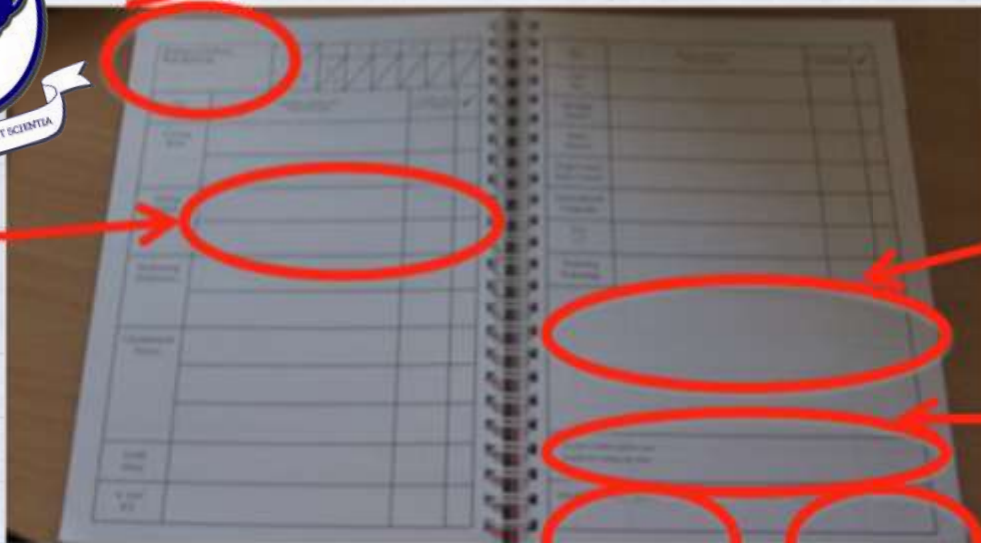
- 1) Review and practise work completed in class
- 2) Develop an understanding of a theme/concept before attention is given to it in the lessons.
- 3) Extend the learning by applying skills and understanding to new situations

The contact book is used by learners to note homework and important notices. Parents can keep an eye on what work the pupils have at any time and whether or not it has been completed. Also, the contact book may be used as a communication method between the school and the home (although the school also uses the texting system to praise and to note concerns if needed e.g. unfinished homework).

Every pupil has the responsibility to complete their homework to the highest standard possible. This is done with support from the school, and very often from the parents. The school offers support in several ways including:



Teachers share feedback with pupils about their work – this can be during or after a pupil has completed a task. The pupil is expected to respond to these targets. Usually, the success criteria are discussed with learners, and they are used to complete self and peer assessment using WWW/EBI.

These are some things a parent can do to help their child:

- *Create an area where there are no major disturbances (quiet room – dining room).*
- *Ensure there are appropriate resources available to complete the work.*
- *Encourage a routine.*
- *Read the completed work and discuss WWW and EBI.*
- *Limit outside activities if conflict arises.*
- *Discuss the work, show an interest.*
- *If there is a test, test the child after a short period of revision e.g. 15 minutes.*
- *Visit place of educational interest e.g. museums and discuss what is interesting and why.*
- *Discuss current affairs and read newspapers/watch news items on the television as this will develop the child's knowledge and understanding*
- ***Praise the child for working effectively***

As a school we understand that homework can cause **problems** and we're always willing to work with the child and parent to overcome any difficulties. We encourage parents to contact the school where any problems do arise. These are examples of problems:

- *Homework can overwhelm some pupils and cause a negative attitude towards school.*
- *Homework can prevent young people taking part in out-of-school interests.*
- *Homework can strain relationships in the family.*
- *Homework disrupt family life and routines.*

- *Parents may lack confidence in supporting their child – e.g. In unfamiliar or complex tasks.*

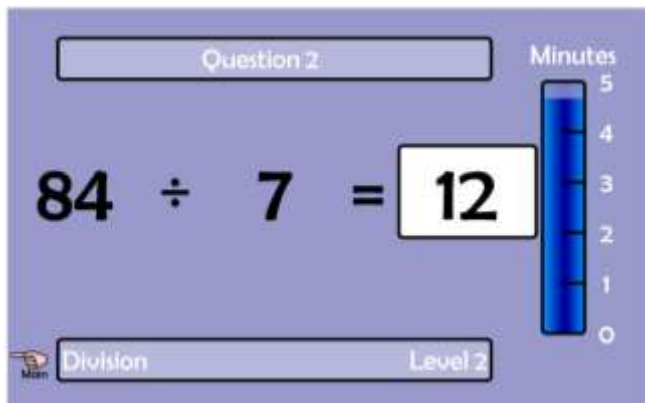
Bedtime Maths

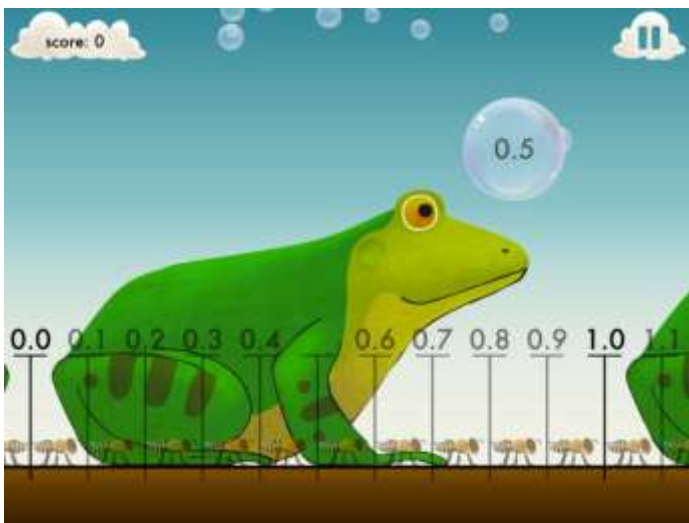

Year 12 field work Plas Tan y Bwlch 21st-22nd of November 2012

The first day was spent investigating the river Glaslyn. We went with pupils from Ysgol Syr Huw Owen, Ysgol y Berwyn and Ysgol Tryfan. We were split into groups in order to cover a larger area of the river. The first measurements were taken from the middle section of the river and we took measurements of the river's width, depth and gradient. We also measured the rate of flow and the rock type at different sections.

The second measurements were taken at the river's source and we repeated the same technique as we did downstream. This was followed by investigating flood defences and regimes in Bedd Gelert looking at the flood warning systems and the high risk houses located on the river banks.

We ventured into Betws y Coed on the second day where we attempted to carry out an index of rural survey but unfortunately the weather got the better of us and nobody could read the datasheets. We then retreated to Tan Y Bwlch to dry off and continued with our surveys using online sources which proved that secondary data isn't as reliable as primary data.
