Word from the headteacher

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Dear Parent/Carers

At the end of a very busy term, I believe that we have successfully merged the two schools; good cohesion has been achieved with staff, children and parents working together as one.

Many activities have been co-organised as seen in this edition of **Ein Bro**

- Christmas boxes for the **Operation Christmas Child** for Belarus were collected on both sites
- The pupils studying Welsh in the Sixth Form held a workshop in the primary school in order to compose a welcoming poem for the Maldwyn and the vicinity Eisteddfod, to be held in Meifod in August 2015
- The Year 12 Enterprise group organised a Halloween party on the primary site as part of their Welsh Baccalaureate Qualification; this included a best pumpkin competition
- Members of staff from both primary and secondary sectors have been meeting on a weekly basis to plan schemes of work, from the Foundation Phase all the way through to Key Stage 4
 - Close co-operation has also been established between Ysgol Bro Hyddgen and The Federation Schools (Carno, Llanbrynmair and Glantwymyn)
- I would like to congratulate the primary school children and staff for their excellent Christmas production of **Nadolig y Rwlá**
 - Three performances were staged for the pupils themselves: one for the youngest children in the Cylch Meithrin and Community Nursery; another to the rest of the primary school children and yet another for Year 7 pupils
 - Two performances were held for the parents with the hall packed full on both occasions
- It is now possible for children and staff to use computers on both sites with the files being saved centrally on our new file servers
 - I would like to thank Tomi Rowlands, Tom Sedgeman and John Behnan for their work. Whilst there are still some teething problems with the phone system, we are hopeful that they will be sorted in the near future
- The text messaging system will be extended to the primary sector along with a rewards system, similar to the secondary pattern
 - As parents you will receive messages to inform you about day to day events and your child's successes, including good effort and excellent work. More details will follow in the new year

Attendance

I would like to thank you for your support in ensuring that the school's percentage attendance record stands at just over 95% - the school's target for the year.

The Welsh Government has recently changed its focus regarding attendance; in previous years the focus was on unauthorised absence. However, in order to improve attendance levels and to decrease absenteeism across the board, the focus is now on all absences. Some of you may have received letters expressing concerns that your child's attendance has been less than 90%. The Welsh Government would like the table below to be shared with all parents.

Your child's attendance	National Guidelines
95 – 100%	Optimum chance to achieve well. Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.
90 – 95%	Satisfactory. Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.
85 – 90%	Cause for concern. This is equivalent to missing half a day of school per week. Your child may be at risk of underachieving.
80 – 85%	Cause for concern. Your child may need extra support from you to catch up with work.
Below 80%	This is equivalent to missing one day of school per week. Your child may be missing out on a broad and balanced education.

I hope you will continue to support the school in this matter, bearing in mind that every day counts and that there is never a good time to take holidays when your child should be at school.

Powys students helping to remove the fear of starting a new school



The transition from primary to secondary school can be a terrifying time, so a group of students are creating a film to bust the myths and help ease the move.

Oliver Lanz, 17, and his group from Ysgol Bro Hyddgen in Machynlleth, remember hearing rumours that only made their own fears and worries worse.

So they have been working with Fixers – a charity that supports young people aged 16-25 to tackle any issue that matters to them, however they choose – to create a film to break down misconceptions and help Year 6 students integrate.

“Everyone feels anxious,” says Oliver. “I did. The night before you don’t get enough sleep, you’re awake, and constantly thinking ‘What’s going to happen? What do I do?’”

“My friends and I came together to talk about what we remembered and our worries.

“Working with Fixers, we are turning this into a film to help Year 6 primary school children feel less worried about going to secondary school.”

The question and answer style film will be a mix of animation and interviews with four previous Year 7 students. It will follow a girl talking about why she is worried and the students answering her questions and challenging myths.

“The girl has got all the normal worries that every child has,” says Oliver. “The four students answer her questions and help her relax by telling her not to worry and that it is really simple.

“We’ll do versions of our film in English and in Welsh.”

Catrin Hughes, Head of Year 7 at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen, thinks it will really help students coming up from primary school.

“It’s great for the school itself and all the teachers,” she said, “It makes the school a happier place and it makes the pupils a lot happier as well.”

Oliver and his friends hope to show the film in primary schools. He said: “The underlying message is everyone is in the same boat and you are going to spend the next five years with these people, so you may as well not worry and just get on with it.”

Fixers works with young people across the UK. Each Fixer is supported by the charity’s in-house team of creative professionals in producing a resource to get their chosen message across. Many young people choose to create a short film, website, poster campaign, information leaflet, or hold an event or flashmob.

Fixers has already supported over 13,900 young people across the UK in creating an authentic voice in their community.

Young people have campaigned with Fixers on issues as diverse as cyber-bullying, self-harm, suicide and the need for more random acts of kindness.

Fixers aims to work with over 70,000 young people aged 16 to 25 by 2020 to help them to take action and tackle the issues they feel strongly about and to do this it needs to raise funds. Visit www.fixers.org.uk for more information.

A football tournament was held in Machynlleth leisure centre on the 24th of October by our Mentor Group. It fulfils part of the Welsh Bac. qualification **Working with Others**, raises awareness of blindness in Wales and develops Welsh language use. Members of the Group included; Aron, Joel, Rebecca and Faye. Teams of 5 competed against each other including one Very Intelligent Group, the teachers, including Miss Erin Good, Miss Anna Davies, Mr Tegid Owen, Mr Llifon Ellis a Mr Aled Myrddin. The head teacher of the school Mr Dafydd Jones was at hand to referee the game. Playing against the teachers were teams including pupils from years 10, 11 and 12. To ensure the games were as realistic as possible every player apart from the goal keeper had to wear a blindfold and relied on their hearing to control the ball. A special ball with bells inside it was used for the games.

This led to some interesting situations with the ball rolling around the hall and everyone kicking the ball into the air. One of the hardest responsibilities for Mr

Jones was to ensure that no one was cheating and looking through the blindfold. Some of the audience did have their suspicions as to who the real cheats were. Many memorable goals were scored, not least Mr Tegid Owen's goal against Year 12. Legend!

Harry Hughes (Deputy Head Pupil) also played a part in the event by working as commentator. His unique twist of humour added greatly to this very exciting event. Welsh Sinfonia Project

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Concert in Ysgol Bro Hyddgen as part of Welsh Sinfonia Project



Currently Bro Hyddgen, along with four other schools in Wales, is part of 'Crescendo' an exciting five year project with the Welsh Sinfonia. The goal is to build and promote orchestral playing in secondary schools. The project is sponsored by the Arts Council. Mark Eager, the conductor visited twice to hold workshops with the school band and visited a third time with his orchestra of 18 members from the Orchestra of Wales. It was an amazing and surreal experience to have the opportunity to play in an orchestra with professional and experienced players. Their intention was to share their experience with us whilst teaching us at the same time. It was also interesting to see and hear the instruments that are not played by the pupils in the orchestra, for example the double bass, violin, viola and bassoon.

We practiced all afternoon, then at 7 o'clock on Thursday evening we had the opportunity to play with the orchestra in a special concert. We played three pieces with the orchestra Vivaldi's Autumn, Waller's Ain't Misbehaving, and Strauss's Radetsky March. The orchestra also played well-known pieces that gave the night a real buzz. In addition to this, three pupils were given the opportunity to play as soloists with the orchestra accompanying which was an amazing experience. Rhian Griffiths performed Vivaldi's Winter on the flute before being joined by Dafydd Duggan in performing a duet arrangement for piano and orchestra of Sabre Dance by Khachaturian. Gruffydd Behnan also performed an arrangement of Softly Awakes My Heart on

the Cornet with the Orchestra.

So the experience was one weird but totally amazing. It was a great experience for experienced players as well as the inexperienced players in the school. Before this project there were pupils who had not even thought about playing instruments let alone playing with professional musicians. This was most evident in the Percussion section which included an interesting variety of noisy and expensive instruments! It was interesting to see how the players work, from their initial tuning to their musical interaction. Certainly it was an unforgettable experience. We are so grateful to Mrs Llio James that gave us the opportunity to be part of the project and to Mrs Sally Marshall (Wind) and all the other traveling teachers Philip Pryce (Brass) Kay Davies (Harp) and Steffan Jones (Percussion) for training us to such a standard.

We hope to work with Mark Eager and the orchestra in the future and we are already looking forward to it!

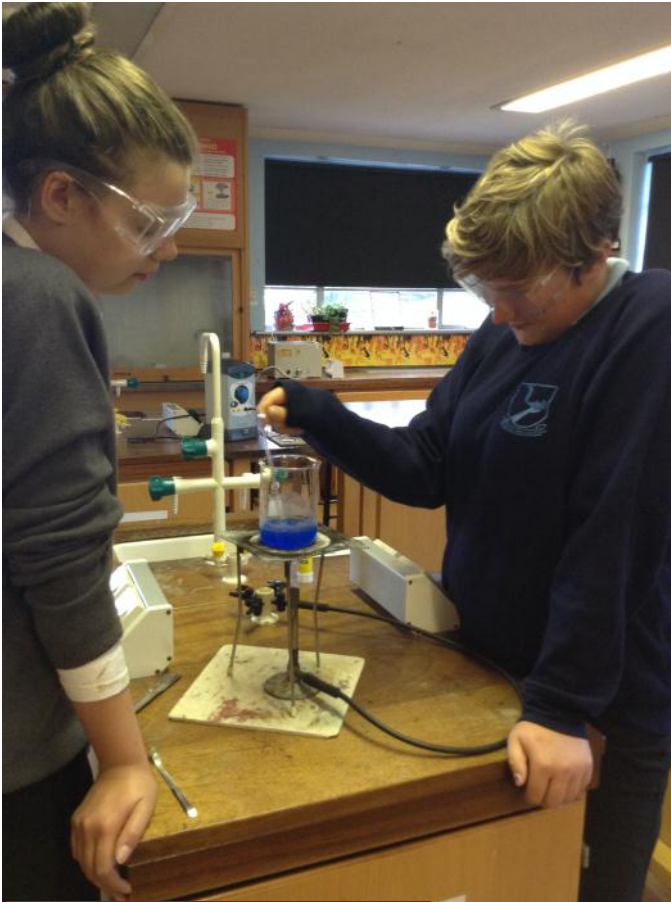

For my first tournament this result wasn't too bad. I was the only player on my team that has never played for Wales before and it was a brilliant experience. Not only am I the first boy from Machynlleth to represent Wales in pool, but I was also the second youngest on the team. It was a great experience; I hope I can represent my country again.
