Letter from the headteacher

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Dear Parents/Carers

A number of staff will be leaving at the end of term: Mrs Carwen Williams is retiring after over 30 years of excellent service to the school. I hope that she will enjoy her retirement and will be able to visit her son, Tom, in Canada. I would also like to thank Mrs Lydia Jones, Ms Llinos Griffiths and Miss Nia Lois Griffiths who are finishing at the Primary campus this summer; they have all showed admirable dedication to their work over the years.

I would like to congratulate Mrs Cath Lloyd Williams on the birth of her son Mostyn; we look forward to welcoming her back at the end of this term. I would also like to welcome Miss Angharad Elias who will be joining the Welsh department at the Secondary Campus in September.

There have been some other staffing changes following Mrs Haf ap Robert's move to lead the Primary Campus. Mr Llifton Ellis has been appointed the new Head of Sixth Form; Mr Tegid Owen and Miss Erin Good have been jointly appointed to lead Years 7-9 and Mr Alwyn Jones has been appointed to lead Years 3-6. Miss Anna Rhys Davies and Mr Iwan Biffin have been jointly appointed as Child Protection and Additional Learning Needs Leaders. I would like to congratulate them all and wish them well in their new posts.

It would be pleasing to start a campaign to buy a new school mini bus. Not so long ago there used to be a community bus kept at the school. We currently spend thousands of pounds on hiring buses for both campuses. It would serve the school budget well if the school could purchase its own bus in order to ensure that the pupils can continue to participate in activities at a time where funds are very low.

During the summer term a number of pupils have not been adhering to the school uniform policy on the secondary campus. I would like to remind you that we expect the secondary campus children to wear a white shirt, purple tie, black trousers (not jeans), a V neck jumper and black shoes (not trainers). The uniform can be bought on line

from Constructiv Clothing, Newtown.

*I believe it is fair to say that this year has been a very successful year for Ysgol Bro Hyddgen despite local media occasionally reporting to the contrary. The school was more successful in the Urdd Eisteddfod than any other year, with the children competing successfully against many larger schools. I would like to thank the teachers for giving up their time to tutor the children. Many of the school pupils competed successfully in the Montgomery Society competitions; also in sporting, art & science activities. Pupils have also taken part in three excellent and truly memorable performances: the **Welsh Sinffonia** in November, **Frozen** in December and **Efengyl Tangnefedd** in January.*

Cemeg SusNet Chemistry Prifysgol Aberystwyth—Aberystwyth University



Uned SUSNET Cemeg at Technoleg Gwyrdd

Mae'r uned yma yn ffocysu ar elfennau o dechnoleg gwyrdd ac wedi cael ei gyflwyno gan Dr Ifat Parveen sydd yn ymchwilydd gwyddonol ac yn ddarlithydd Cemeg yn IBERS.

Gwnaeth Meinri Jones a Mared Ingram o Ysgol Bro Hyddgen ymuno â'r sesiynau ymarferol gyda myfyrwyr o Ysgol Penglais a oedd yn gofyn iddynt gynnal arbrofion gwyddonol ac ymchwiliadau. Cafodd y myfyrwyr i gyd gyfle i ymweld â'r adeilad newydd, 'Beacon' sydd wedi cael ei lleoli yn y Brifysgol ac yn fodd o gefnogi busnesau yng Nghymru.

Gwnaeth Prifysgol Aberystwyth sylw arbennig yn datgan eu batchder o'n myfyrwyr am roi o'u gwirfodd i fod yn rhan o'r gweithgareddau hyn.

SusNet Chemistry Unit Green Technology

This unit focussed on aspects of Green Technology and was delivered by Dr Ifat Parveen, Senior Research Scientist and lecturer in Chemistry in IBERS.

Meinri Jones and Mared Ingram from Ysgol Bro Hyddgen joined students from Ysgol Penglais in practical sessions led by Ifat which included the production of bioethanol via fermentation, an investigation into oil extraction from vegetable matter, the production of biodiesel and exploring oil viscosity. All the students were also given a guided tour of the Beacon Facility, which is based at the University, and helps Welsh businesses develop new ways of converting crops such as rye grass into products including pharmaceuticals, chemicals, fuels and cosmetics.

Aberystwyth University added that the girls are very impressive to give up their own precious time and make the effort to come to the University, we were very impressed indeed. A real credit to Ysgol Bro Hyddgen.

Fel rhan o uned o waith Rhifedd yn seiliedig ar gynllunio parc adloniant, bu disgyblion dosbarth 5/6H a 5/6J ar drip i Gelli Gyffwrdd ddydd Llun, 20 Mehefin. Yn ystod y tymor bu'r disgyblion yn ymchwilio i nodweddion parciau adloniant, yn casglu a chyflwyno data am hoff atyniadau, ac yn cymharu prisiau tocynnau mewn parciau eraill gan ystyried beth sy'n cynnig gwerth gorau am arian. Buont yn creu mapiau o'u parciau adloniant, yn datblygu eu gwybodaeth am strategaethau marchnata, ac yn cyfrifo ac olrhain costau.

Cafwyd diwrnod llawn hwyl yng Ngelli Gyffwrdd, ac roedd hyn wedi ysbrydoli'r disgyblion i greu cyflwyniadau am y parciau roeddent wedi eu cynllunio eu hunain.

As part of the numeracy unit of work which focuses on planning a theme park trip the pupils in class 5/6H and 5/6J went on a trip to "Gentli Gyffwrdd" on Monday 20th June. During the term the pupils have been researching the different aspects of a theme park and collecting and presenting information of their favourite items and comparing ticket prices with other parks while considering what makes value for money for their tickets. They were making maps of their theme parks and developing their information for marketing strategies and calculating the profit and costs.

We had a day full of fun in "Ngelli Gyffwrdd" and it was a good inspiration to the pupils to create their presentation about the parks that they have created themselves.

Adran Wythoniaeth—Salters Festival

On Wednesday the 16th/18th of June, four pupils (two from year seven and two from year eight) travelled to Aberystwyth to compete in the annual Salters' festival of Chemistry, in which different schools battle it out to see who is the best at solving chemistry-related problems and conundrums. The four participants were Johann Jones and Oskar Bond of year seven, and two other individuals from year 8. When we arrived, we were treated to an array of biscuits and drinks immediately before entering the laboratory in which we would receive our safety briefing and don our rather fetching lab-coats. After wearing the slightly too large safety goggles provided, putting on the tightest rubber gloves you can imagine and, so that we would be recognised, name tags, we

entered another scientific laboratory, filled with chemicals, chromatography paper and beakers. It was in this very room that we were to attempt to solve our first riddle, which was a classic 'whodunit' case with most probably the worst plot ever written.

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Beth yw COBWEB ?



Mae COBWEB, y Citizen OBServatory WEB, yn gynllun sy'n defnyddio 'gwyddoniaeth gwerin' (*citizen science*) sef galluogi dinasyddion i gasglu gwybodaeth amgylcheddol drwy ddefnyddio technynnau symudol. Bydd y wybodaeth a gesglir yn addas i'w ddefnyddio mewn ymchwil gwyddonol, gwneud penderfyniadau a llunio polisi. Mae COBWEB yn ddibynnol ar yr hyn a elwir yn 'dorfdarddu' (crowdsourcing) sef casglu data gan dorff amhenodol o bobl.

Beth yw gwyddoniaeth gwerin?

Gellir diffinio 'gwyddoniaeth gwerin' yn eang fel cyfraniadau gwirfoddolwyr i wyddoniaeth. Mae'r dull yma o gynnal ymchwil gwyddonol yn dod yn fwy-fwy poblogaidd, gan y gellir casglu toeth o wybodaeth yn gyfleus. Yn ogystal, mae datblygiadau mewn technolegau symudol wedi gwneud gwyddoniaeth gwerin yn ymarferol fel modd o ymchwilio.

Pam cymryd rhan?

Mae COBWEB angen 'gwyddonwyr gwerin' sy'n awyddus i gymryd rhan yn y gweithgareddau ymchwil yma yn ardal Biosffer Dyfi. Nid yn unig y gallech gyfrannu gwybodaeth ond gallech hefyd weld eich cyfraniadau chi ochr yn ochr â data'r 'dorff'.

Beth yw Biosffer Dyfi?

Mae ardaloedd Biosffer yn safleoedd sydd wedi eu dynodi dan raglen Bobl a'r Biosffer UNESCO i hyrwyddo datblygu cynaliadwy ar sail ymdrechion cymunedol a gwyddoniaeth safonol.

Biosffer Dyfi yw'r cyntaf yng Nghymru, un o 631 ardal debyg mewn 119 gwlad ar draws y byd.

Mae'r ardaloedd o gwmpas yr afon Ddyfi yn gartref i rai o dirluniau nodedig a bywyd gwylt gorau Ewrop. Er hynny nid yw'r rhan fwyaf o Fiosffer Dyfi'n ardal o gadwraeth ond yn hytrach yn fan lle mae pobl yn byw ac yn gweithio.



What is COBWEB?



The Citizen Observatory Web is a project concerned with enabling citizens to collect environmental data using mobile devices. These data will be suitable for use in research, decision making and policy formation. COBWEB relies on what is known as crowdsourcing; information (data) collected by an undefined 'crowd' of people.

What is citizen science?

Citizen science can broadly be defined as the involvement of volunteers in science. It is becoming an ever more popular method of performing scientific research because large amounts of data can be collected. Advances in mobile technologies make citizen science increasingly viable as a research tool.

Why take part?

COBWEB needs aspiring citizen scientists to participate in its research activities. Not only can you contribute data, you can also see your contributions online alongside the rest of the crowd's data.

The Dyfi Biosphere

Biosphere Reserves are sites registered under UNESCO's Man and the Biosphere programme to

promote sustainable development based on local community efforts and sound science.

The Dyfi Biosphere is the first in Wales, one of 631 biosphere reserves in 119 countries all over the world. The areas around the river Dyfi host some of the finest examples of special landscapes and wildlife areas in Europe. However, most of the Dyfi Biosphere is not a conservation area, simply places where people live and work.

Fel ysgol rydym wedi bod yn hynod o ffodus i gael y cyfle i fod yn rhan o'r cynllun COBWEB. Mae'r cynllun yma wedi galluogi'r ysgol i ganiatau i'r plant ddefnyddio a datblygu sgilau a'r wybodaeth maent wedi eu dysgu yn y dosbarth a'u cymhwyso i'r byd mawr. Trwy gydweithio gyda'r RSPB yn Ynys Hir mae plant blwyddyn 6, fel rhan o'r wythnos trosglwyddo, wedi llwyddo i gofnodi data wyddonol mewn dull effeithiol drwy ddefnyddio dulliadau ditlysu cywir. Mae'r prosiect hwn hefyd yn fodd o ddatblygu sgiliau Technoleg Gwybodaeth y disgyblion yn effeithiol.

Mae'r ysgol hefyd wedi bod yn ffodus o gael cydweithio gyda'r tîm addysg RSPB dros y 3 blynedd diwethaf i gwblhau prosiect sy'n cofnodi pa anifeiliad sydd yn byw mewn gwahanol gynefinoedd yn y warchodfa natur. Bu'r disgyblion yn defnyddio'u ffonau symudol yn ogystal â meddalwedd COBWEB i gofnodi'r data yma mewn modd priodol a chywir.

Fel rhan o'r cynllun yma mae'r ysgol wedi derbyn gorsaf dywydd sydd am ein galluogi i ddefnyddio'r data yma i gymharu newidiadau mewn tywydd a darganfod mwy o wybodaeth am fathau gwahanol o dywydd ac ym mha fath o hinsawdd y mae'r anifeiliad yn hoffi byw ynddo.

Hoffwn gymryd y cyfle yma i ddiolch i'r tîm addysg RSPB Ynys Hir am eu cymorth ac hefyd y tîm COBWEB am y cyfle i gymryd rhan yn y cynllun yma.

As a school we have been very lucky to have the opportunity to be a part of the COBWEB project. This project has enabled the school and our pupils to give practical uses of the theory we teach in our lessons and to use this knowledge and see how it can be used in the real world. By co-working with the RSPB Ynys Hir education team our pupils were given the opportunity to record scientific information about what animals live in different habitats and using mobile devices the pupils are able to use this technology to gather this information.

The school has also been fortunate to be able to work with the RSPB team over the past 3 years to do a similar project based on which animals live in which habitats with our year 6 during transition week. The nature reserve has been using the portable devices and using validation to ensure the integrity of the data collected and the pupils are giving their feedback on how usable the devices are to use.

As part of this project the school has been donated a weather station in order to record and compare weather conditions with the records we collect. The data can then match which animals prefer which type of habitats and weather conditions.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the RSPB education team for their hard work and but also the COBWEB team for having the opportunity to take part of this project.

This year has been an exciting year of continuous professional development for several teachers at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen. During the 2015 Autumn term, 6 of our teachers – Mrs Gwenan Phillips, Mrs Lowri Evans, Mr Iwan Biffin, Mr Alwyn Dylan Jones, Mr Tegid Owen and Miss Anna Rhys Davies completed the Outstanding Teacher Programme. This was done with teachers from the Carno, Glantwymyn and Llanbrynmair Primary Schools Federation. In the first instance, the programme was presented under the guidance of the University of Wales Trinity Saint David.

The purpose of the training is to develop further understanding by the teachers of outstanding teaching and learning activities within the classroom, and also to develop the teachers' understanding of coaching skills. The programme proved to be so successful that 2 teachers were offered the opportunity by Powys County Council to be trained to deliver the programme, and as a result, Mr Iwan Biffin and Miss Anna Rhys Davies are now qualified to do the work. They have already trained 12 teachers from schools across Powys, including Mr Nic Ros and Mrs Manon Holt; this training happened in Ysgol Bro Hyddgen during the summer term of 2016.

We intend to continue developing as a centre for the Outstanding Teacher Programme, and we're very proud of the fact that teachers from other schools across North Powys are coming to Ysgol Bro Hyddgen to learn from our teaching and learning work. Congratulations to all teachers who have already completed the training successfully.

Local School goes on Micro Safari!

Children from Ysgol Bro Hyddgen have been visiting the Centre for Alternative Technology (CAT) to learn about wild flower meadows and pollinator insects.

Wildflower meadow area has decreased across Wales, and this is not helped by the fact that bee, butterfly and hoverfly populations are in decline (honeybee populations were shown to drop 23% between 1985 and 2005). The value of pollinator species to the UK farming economy is around £430 million. If human beings had to do this pollinating the cost of the same service would be £1.8 billion. Over 200 Foundation phase and Key Stage Two children have studied different habitats, comparing the type of invertebrates found in the meadow and bordering hedgerows. The project, which has been funded by the People's Postcode Lottery, has provided the children with opportunities to conduct a baseline survey of the areas and learn techniques to enhance their own environment for invertebrate species and plant life to support these insects.

The children have learnt how to use scientific equipment including sweep nets, pooters and magnifying pots. They use this equipment to find key animal and plant species among the biodiversity of the CAT site.

The next stage of the project is to link to the school sites and encourage the seeding of pollinator friendly plants and to further develop positive experiences and links between National Curriculum requirements and outdoor learning.

Mrs Haf ap Robert, Assitant Headteacher at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen primary campus said, 'The children have had a really positive learning experience which has enhanced their understanding and appreciation of key aspects of the science curriculum. The scientific knowledge the children have acquired will, I'm certain, be applied across the curriculum; the project may even have pollinated some budding bee keepers of the future! We are very grateful to the People's Postcode Lottery for funding this project.'

Nature Club in the primary campus



The children at the Primary site have been learning about nature in the school grounds and getting their hands grubby searching for insects, building bug houses and completing some land art. Initially the prospect of a Wild Wednesday excited the staff, some thinking of it as a mid-week pick-me-up. but then they realised the club was for the children.

As soon as the project got underway the children became very engaged and we now have 63 very keen nature detectives. So far we have conducted a Bio Blitz of the site: this involved collecting plant species by using a simple string transect and observing what we found. For the insects we used sweep nets to collect from the long grasses on the bank and tipped them out into trays to examine them. A clicking beetle was the highlight.

We had a moth trap kindly set up and shown to us by Elen and Tristan's mum, Heather and found some interesting hawk moths which took our breath away.

Some of the children have been making bug houses to take home. A process of collecting materials and rolling into a cylinder held together by some chicken wire. You can look at the instructions on the Wild Wednesday board in the Primary hall.

We hope to congregate all members on the afternoon of the summer fair (Wednesday 6 July) in order to celebrate our learning and understanding of the natural world.

I hope to see many of the 'Wildweds kids' back next academic year.

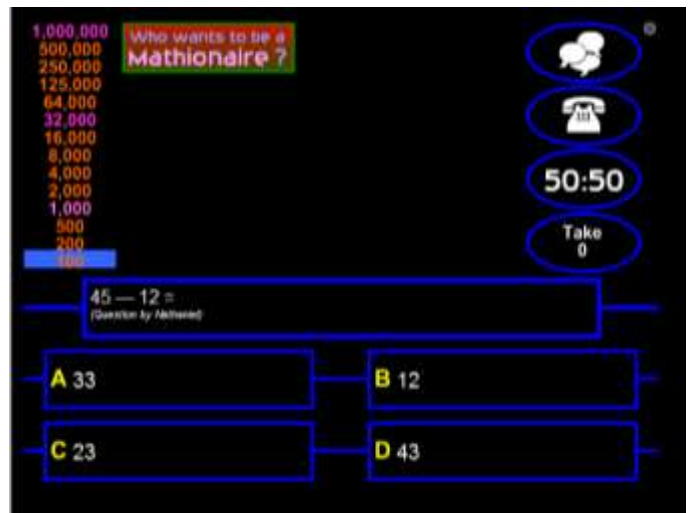
Bedtime Math

The questions on bedtime math are asked in a written format which requires the pupil to interpret the question and work out the sum needed to answer the question. The questions are differentiated for pupils of lower, medium and high ability learners. The question also changes daily.



Brainist Math Games

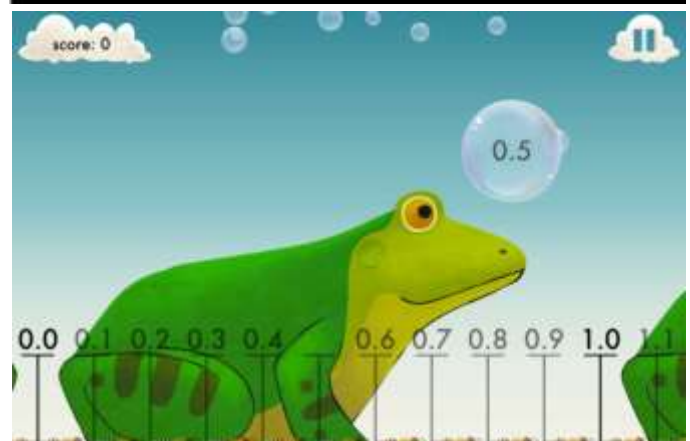
The 'Brainist Math Games' is an excellent website for developing mental maths. It includes multiplications, division, addition and subtracting questions. The objective of the game is to answer a series of questions as quickly as possible.



A website that includes a number of revision resources for GCSE Mathematics including 'Who Wants to be a Millionaire' a game that will interest children and develop their numeracy skills.

Motion Math

A useful App for developing numeracy skills as it includes a number of games that are fun for children. 28 Playful Coding

I'm just back from our penultimate project meeting on the Playful Coding project. It's been a good year-and-a-bit of working, playing, talking to kids, and talking to teachers. After the last week we've really made progress on our main output too, which is a book for teachers and people who want to engage school-aged students with programming and computational thinking using playful workshops.

The Wales team this session were myself, Wayne Aubrey and Nigel Hardy from Aberystwyth University, and Tomi Rowlands, Sam Roberts, and Gwenan Phillips from Ysgol Bro Hyddgen in Machynlleth. One of the real wins of projects like this is the extra time you get to spend with cool local people as well as the time you spend chatting to teachers and lecturers from other countries – we've come up with some good ideas and I think the links we have with Bro Hyddgen now are great.

In May, Girona has a flower festival which means that there are hundreds (literally, hundreds) of floral displays across the town. It also meant that the town was fairly full (hotels were busy and the streets filled up during the afternoon). But we were working pretty much non stop so that didn't bother us too much.

The aim of the project is to write, test and revise workshop activities for schoolkids, and then to write a book explaining what we've done and what we've learned. As we're nearing the end now, we have been mostly writing and testing activities. The group split into 3 sub-groups, to work on different aspects of our remaining tasks, and over the course of the week, we visited three schools and ran 8 workshops as well as adding something like 50 pages of text to our book.

Figueras is famous for one particular guy: Salvador Dali. His museum is there and after we'd been in the school a full day (9-4) we got to visit the museum. It is definitely a museum to recommend – Dali didn't just fill it with pictures, there are sculptures and the very building is surrealist. If you get to go try to get a tour as the tour guide was great at explaining what was actually going on behind the art. Believe me, there's a lot going on behind the art. From 6-8 that evening we gathered in a coffee bar to have a Dali-themed Scratch Hackathon. Here's a picture of Wayne and I working on our respective Scratch programs. I thought it was a lovely idea to get us staff engaging with Scratch and playful coding – if you spend all your time talking about how coding should be fun without actually doing any fun coding... it can get difficult to maintain the enthusiasm.

Eduard Muntaner (EduardM on scratch and on twitter) has put together a studio of the scratch outputs we made that evening – there are some fun animations. I made a video activated Dali face

where the moustache twirls when you move in front of your laptop camera.

We visited Escola Veinat in Salt (a suburb of Girona) the next day, and ran workshops on Mindstorms and on Scratch. The Scratch workshop had been written by the Romanian team, was being delivered by the Catalan team and my job was to observe, along with an Italian colleague. This multiple observers approach is one of the real strengths of these training meetings – we try out each others' materials, and we critique them, and we revise them.

They're actually getting really good now. Here I am in the classroom, trying to observe rather than help. It was fairly easy not to help too much as my Catalan is not very good at all...

In the evening we had a talk from Maria Antonia Canals, who is an absolute superstar in terms of pedagogical theory in Spain. She is 84 or something like that and has had the most amazing life, working in schools and in teacher training for so long and in such a creative and thoughtful way. Her specialism is the teaching of mathematics, particularly systems which make maths tangible and she's invented some really superb systems for explaining abstract concepts to little kids.



On the penultimate day, we went to St George's School, which is an English language instruction school outside of Girona where we could run 4 parallel workshops. I ran the AppInventor workshop with some 13-year-olds, which after a couple of technology related hiccups went quite well. The kids were amazingly quick to pick it up so even though we'd lost a bit of time to setup, everyone managed to write a basic drawing app and get it onto their phones/tablets.



Whilst I was working on the AppInventor workshop my Aber colleague Nigel was helping out with a Scratch workshop. I think the other workshops were all scratch activities, actually – the school is a 3-18 school so we were able to run workshops, in English or in French, across all age groups.



It was then back to the University of Girona for a quick tour of their underwater robotics lab, and then another afternoon spent working on our book. The book is getting there, the robots are awesome.
