


Gair gan y Pennaeth

Er mai tymor byr yw tymor y Gwanwyn mae wedi bod yn un prysur iawn gydag arholiadau allanol ym mis Ionawr, arholiadau llafar, asesiadau dan reolaeth a llawer iawn o waith cwrs yn cael ei gwblhau.

Rhannodd Gwenno Griffiths a Lisa Jones y wobr gyntaf yn Eisteddfod Llanegryn yn y gystadleuaeth ysgrifennu rhyddiaith o dan 25 oed ac roedd yr ysgol yn llwyddiannus iawn eto yn Eisteddfod yr Urdd gyda nifer fawr yn edrych ymlaen at gystadlu yn yr Eisteddfod Genedlaethol yn Sir Benfro. Hoffwn longyfarch pawb am gystadlu a diolch i'r staff wnaeth eu hyfforddi.

Cynhaliwyd noson Gweld Sêr ym Mis Chwefror lle cafodd bawb gyfle i weld tair ffilm a gynhyrchwyd gan Blwyddyn 9 yn ystod yr Wythnos Gweithgareddau llynedd. 


A word from the Headteacher

Dear Parent / Carer

Although this term has been short, it has been a very busy one for pupils and staff. External examinations were held in January; whilst oral examinations, controlled assignments and a massive amount of coursework have been undertaken during the term.

If your child is in Years 10 - 13, he/she should have created a revision timetable and started revising. The first examination will be held on Monday 13 May, which is in six weeks. As parents you have a very important role, you can help your children to revise by encouraging them and ensuring they have a quiet area to work (away from the television and other distractions). Revision works well when it's done in a series: where the child revises the same topic for a series of three or four consecutive nights. Statistics show that people, in four weeks' time, remember around 80% of the work revised in this way. However 90% of the work will be forgotten if the work is only revised for one night.



Many revision sessions will be held at the school during the Easter break for years 10 – 13. You should have received information about revision sessions by post. Details are also to be found on the school website.

In 2012 our attendance percentage was 94.2% which

placed us in Band 2 for attendance. The present attendance percentage is 92.8% which places the school in Band 3 for attendance. It is important that as parents you do everything possible to ensure your child attends school every day. **Remember that every day counts and there is no good time to take holidays during school term.**

There have been many successes during the term, with Year 8 working in partnership with the RSPB to design and create graphics work for a new hide at the centre. Era Masko won the Art prize at the Montgomeryshire Society awards and Lois Jones won first prize for writing a story titled One Moonlit Night. Hanna Eiddon Lewis won second prize. Gweno Griffiths and Lisa Jones shared first prize for prose writing in Eisteddfod Llanegryn and the school was very successful again this year in the Urdd Eisteddfod with many pupils looking forward going to competing at the national Eisteddfod in Pembrokeshire. I would like to thank everyone who competed and also the staff who tutored them.

In February the award ceremony, Gweld Sêr (Seeing Stars), was held. Three films, produced by Year 9 during the Activities Week last year, were screened. The films were excellent and the evening itself a great success. I'd like to thank Mr Nic Ros, Mr Alex Roberts and Mr Huw Davies for their hard work. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the staff and the pupils for their hard work during the year and also you, the parents, for your support.

I hope you all have a happy Easter.





Yn Adran Ddaearyddiaeth

Helo fy enw i yw Finn. Roeddwn i'n un o'r 26 a aeth ar daith i Wlad yr Ia ym mis Chwefror eleni. Trefnwyd y daith gan Discover The World ac roedden nhw wedi gwneud gwaith arbennig o drefnu law yn llaw â Mrs Eirian Davies. I gychwyn roeddem yn hedfan o faes awyr Heathrow yr holl ffordd i Reykjavik. Wedyn teithion ni i'r Blue Lagoon—dyma un o'r llefyydd gorau i mi ymweld ag o erioed! Wedyn aethom ni i weld rhaeadr o'r enw Seljalandsfoss sydd yn lliifo dros glogwyni basalt. Roedd modd i ni gerdded tu ôl y rhaeadr yma ac roedd o'n anhygoel bod tu ôl i rywbeth mor fawr - agoriad llygad! Wedyn fe welsom y llosgfynydd cwsgr Stori-Dimon. Roedd hwn yn rhywbeth nad anghofiaf mohono byth oherwydd bod modd gweld mor bell. I orffen yr ail ddiwrnod aethom i ymweld â'r ail raeadr o'r enw Skogafoss - tirffurf anhygoel arall.

Yn ystod ein trydydd diwrnod aethom i ymweld â Vik. Dyma dref arfordirol gyda tywod du o amgylch yr arfordir - roedd yma olygfeydd anhygoel o'r pentyrâu

basalt wrth ymyl y môr. Wrth ymyl hwnnw roedd Dyrholaey— mae'r enw'n golygu 'drws bryn yr ynys' efo'r creigiau naturiol sydd yn 120m o uchder. Mae'n debyg i'r pentir yma gael ei ffurfio gan ffrwydiad danfor. Mae'r lle yn enwog am ei fywyd adar diddorol fel y pâl. Yn anffodus doedd dim cyfle i weld yr un pâl oherwydd mae nhw'n anifeiliad yr haf. Hveragerdi oedd y dref nesaf a welsom - mae'r dref hon yn llawn gweithgareddau geothermal. Mae o'n ddiddorol iawn cael dysgu am yr hanes yma. Aethom hefyd i'r ffynhonnau poeth sydd wedi bod yna ers y daeargrynn yn 2008.

Ar y pedwerydd diwrnod, aethom i ddringo'r crater folcanig o'r enw Kerid sydd yn dirwedd hardd iawn eto. Credir iddo fod yno yn sgil ffrwydrad folcanig enfawr. Yn dilyn hyn, aethom i weld rhaeadr Gulfoss; dyma'r rhaeadr enwocaf un yng Ngwlad yr Ia - a does dim rhaid gofyn pam. Mae o'n enfawr ac yn gret ym mhob ffordd efo disgyniad o 33m wedyn plymiad i geunant sy'n filltir o hyd. Wedyn, aethom i ymweld â Geysir, y ffynhonnau poeth. Bob 5-7munud mae'r ffynhonnau yma yn ffrwydro ac yn ymestyn i 30m o uchder. I orffen y diwrnod yma, aethom ar daith bws i weld y *Northern Lights*. Goleuwyd yr awyr mewn gwyrdd llachar ac roedd y profiad hwn yn sicr yn glo perffaith i daith anhygoel.

I orffen y daith, ar y pumed diwrnod, aethom i weld y pontydd sy'n ymestyn rhwng y cyfandiroedd. Roedd yr hanes yn ddiddorol iawn ac unwaith eto roedd y tirlun yn berffaith.

The Geography Department

Hi, my name is Robin. This February we went to Iceland where we visited many different places. On the first day there we arrived at Keflavik airport and caught a bus to go swimming in a geothermally-heated outdoor pool called The Blue Lagoon. Later on we checked in to the hotel in Reykjavik. We then went to a restaurant in the city centre.

On the second day we left the hotel at 9:00a.m and got on the bus with a tour guide. We later went sightseeing around Reykjavik and looked at local landmarks such as the Old Port that is globally famous for its fishing and whaling, and a massive lake in the city centre that was fully frozen over with people walking over it. Later on we went to the volcanic town of Hveragerdi that is famous for its volcanically heated greenhouses. Later that day we climbed the non-active volcano Stori-Dimon and had a great view of the flood plains and the deposits from the melting glaciers. While we were in the same area we went to see the massive 60m waterfall Skogafoss. We then went to a hotel in a rural village called Brekkur and to see some coastal landforms.

On the third day there we set off from the hotel at 9:00a.m to a town called Vik that is built on the south most point of Iceland. After going to Vik we went to a beach

with black volcanic sand called Reynisverfi. At midday we went to a farmhouse at the bottom of Eyjafjallajokull with a home cinema where we watched a documentary about the eruption of 2010. Later that day we went back to Reykjavik to another outdoor swimming pool called Laugardalslaug, similar to The Blue Lagoon. After we went back to the hotel for the night.

On the fourth day we left the hotel and went to see Hellisheidi Geothermal Power Station from the outside. After seeing the power station we went to see a volcano with a massive crater in it, called Kerid. The next landmark we went to see was Gullfoss which is a double waterfall that flows off down a canyon. We then went to a geyser called Geysir that spouts water up to 30m every 5-7 minutes. Later that night we went to see the Northern Lights. On the last day we went to see the hot spring water storage plant before we returned to the airport.

MTB Skills Academy Session Details 2013

Run by Welsh Cycling Performance MTB Coach Scott Bugden, Skills Academy Sessions focus on Cross Country MTB racing skills but will help you become a better rider whatever your discipline-including road and track!

The day is split into two sessions: the morning sessions from 10am-12noon are open to any rider aged 10-16 and focus on skills and short race efforts-riders are asked to bring flat pedals for this part of the session in order to develop good technique. The younger riders (Under-12) are finished for the day but not so for the older riders. Following a short break for some food and a rest the over 12's continue for another 2hours, finishing at around 2:30pm. The afternoon session normally consists of a ride to a technically challenging area or trail that riders can then session before riding back to the base.

Sirhowy Valley. Sirhowy Valley is just north of Newport and is a much more natural venue-there is a grass area for the morning skills session and some technical natural trails for the afternoon. Potentially very slippery if it is wet so bring grippy tyres if you have a choice (this applies more for the afternoon session than the morning).

Margam Park. Margam Park is a well-known venue having hosted National races for many years. There is a good mix of trails and technical challenges with some steep climbs/descents.

Brechfa. In West Wales, Brechfa and Abergorlech are two great trail centres that are also really quiet. We will only be running a couple of sessions here throughout the year because of the location but it is well worth the trip with some great riding available. There is also a range of trails available for parents if you want to kill some time.

North:

Nant BH (near Betws Y Coed). Nant BH is an Outdoor Education Centre with a purpose built skills course. It is also in the middle of the Marin Trail and has a classroom area, showers and toilets-all in all, a fantastic venue.

Coed y Brenin (near Dolgellau). Another great North Wales venue, Coed y Brenin has a great natural area that we use for these sessions. Away from the main public trails, it isn't used by any other riders so there is plenty of scope for us to choose different paths/trails and challenges.



To help develop pupils' numeracy skills we have introduced a numeracy question of the week on the school's Twitter (@broddyfi). We are trying to encourage every student to take part in the numeracy question of the week on Twitter. There will be a prize for the pupil that correctly answers the most questions at the end of each term.

Numeracy and Literacy Tests

This May the Welsh Assembly Government is launching their statutory Numeracy and Literacy tests for year 7, 8 and 9 pupils. The tests corresponds to the governments objectives which is to raise numeracy and literacy standards in schools. This year there will be one numeracy test the numeracy procedural test with the numeracy reasoning test being introduced next year. The duration of the numeracy procedural test is 30 minutes and the literacy test an hour. As a school we will be helping pupils prepare for the tests by conducting mock tests along with the numeracy activities that already exist such as the numeracy morning and the numeracy question of the week.





Mapiau meddwl





Trefnu'r gwaith a'r adolygu



Hefyd, pwysleisiodd Jay o Positively MAD sawl peth diddorol arall yn ei gyflwyniad gan gynnwys:

Eistedd fyny'n syth – mae hyn yn caniatáu i waed ac ocsigen lifo i'r ymennydd, ac mae hyn yn hwyluso'r broses o ddysgu a chofio.

Mae pobl yn cofio 90% o beth maent yn ei ddysgu i rywun arall, ac felly mae'n werth gofyn i'ch plentyn ddysgu i chi beth maent wedi ei ddysgu yn ystod y cyfnod adolygu diwethaf.

Peidio adolygu gyda ffôn symudol a Facebook ar waith – mae defnyddio ffôn symudol a Facebook fel arfer yn gwastraffu 40 munud. Dylid cadw defnyddio rhain at amser egwyl – hynny yw, adolygu am 45 munud ac yna 15 munud i siarad gyda ffrindiau ar y ffôn neu'r we.

Holiadur Blwyddyn 11 – adolygu ac arholiadau

Cyn ffug arholiadau Rhagfyr, osbarthwyd holiadur i 15



o ddisgyblion Blwyddyn 11. Roedd rhai o'r atebion i'r holiaduron yn ddiddorol iawn ac yn atgyfnerthu'r uchod wrth drafod **patrymau gweithio gartref** y disgylbion:

Roedd sawl un o'r disgylbion wedi nodi nad oeddynt yn gweithio ddigon caled yn y cartref, ac yn dweud bod **y we, gemau cyfrifiadurol a'r ffôn symudol** yn denu gormod o'u sylw. Mae hyn yn cyd-fynd gyda beth ddywedodd Jay o Positively MAD sef bod budd i ddisgyblion fod yn gweithio dan oruchwyliaeth yn rhywle heblaw'r ystafell wely a lle bynnag arall mae'r pethau hyn ar gael i'w defnyddio heb reolaeth.

Nododd ambell un hefyd eu bod yn treulio **gormod o amser allan gyda'u ffrindiau** ac yr hoffent i'w rhieni eu cadw yn y tŷ am gyfnodau adolygu penodol. Mae cael amser i ymlacio hefyd yn bwysig, ond mae angen cydbwysedd, ac mae'r cyfnod cyn yr arholiadau yn gyfnod pwysig o adolygu.

Roedd mwyafrif y bechgyn a holwyd, a rhai o'r merched yn dweud eu bod **eisiau i'w rhieni eu helpu i greu a rheoli amserlen adolygu**.

Gwelwyd ambell un o'r disgylbion yn dweud bod **brodyr a chwiorydd iau yn tarfu** ar eu gwaith, a bod cael llonydd i adolygu yn gallu bod yn anodd. Awgrymwyd wrth ddisgyblion sy'n byw yn y dref y gallent ddefnyddio llyfrgell y dref ar gyfer adolygu ac mae'r ysgol ar agor am gyfnodau helaeth o'r gwyliau a than tua 6.00 o'r gloch bob nos.

Roedd mwyafrif y bechgyn, a rhai o'r merched wedi dweud eu bod yn dymuno bod eu **rhieni yn eistedd gyda hwy wrth iddynt adolygu**, a'u bod yn eu profi ar yr hyn a ddysgwyd, yn syth ar ddiwedd y sesiwn adolygu, ac o fewn 2-3 diwrnod i weld os oeddynt yn dal i gofio'r wybodaeth.

Dyweddodd sawl un hefyd eu bod yn dymuno bod eu rhieni yn trafod gyda hwy y broses o gwblhau cyn bapurau arholiad; buasai hyn yn atgyfnerthu beth mae'r disgylbion wedi ei ddysgu yn yr ysgol.

Beth mae'r athrawon wedi ei wneud am ganlyniadau'r holiadur?

Adroddwyd yn ôl ar ganlyniadau'r holiadur i athrawon yr ysgol hefyd, a gwelwyd criw o athrawon yn rhannu gwybodaeth mewn sesiwn rhannu arfer dda am sut maent yn paratoi disgylbion ar gyfer arholiadau e.e. adnabod a rhannu nodweddion atebion mathau gwahanol o gwestiynau, ymdopi â geirfa annisgwyl yn yr arholiad, a datblygu dealltwriaeth disgylbion o eiriau gorchymyn. Rhannwyd hefyd wybodaeth am safle gwe Quizlet (<http://quizlet.com/>) sef safle gwe lle mae'n bosib creu a chwarae cwisiau adolygu. Mae'r disgylbion sydd eisoes wedi mentro defnyddio'r safle gwe hwn wedi mwynhau'r gwaith a hefyd yn dweud ei fod o gymorth mawr wrth adolygu. Anogir pob disgylb felly i roi tro arni.

Yn olaf...

Yn nogfen yr OECD am brofion PISA ar sut gall rhieni helpu eu plant i lwyddo yn yr ysgol (<http://www.pisa.oecd.org/dataoecd/4/1/49012097.pdf>), nodir bod disgylbion yn fwy tebygol o lwyddo mewn arholiadau pan yn 15 mlwydd oed (sef TGau yng Nghymru), ac yn debygol o fod â sgiliau darllen gwell os yw'r canlynol yn digwydd:

- Rhieni yn darllen gyda phlant gan ddechrau pan fyddant yn blant ifanc iawn
- Rhieni yn trafod llyfrau, ffilmiau a rhaglenni teledu gyda'u plant
- Rhieni yn trafod beth a ddysgwyd yn yr ysgol yn ddyddiol
- Y teulu yn bwyta prydiau bwyd gyda'i gilydd o gwmpas bwrdd
- Y rhieni a'r plant yn sgwrsio ac yn trafod materion cymdeithasol a gwleidyddol

Parents supporting their children

Needless to say, **all** parents wish to see their child being happy and successful, and all parents work hard for this to happen. At Ysgol Bro Ddyfi, we are very lucky of the support our pupils receive from their parents, and we are proud of the co-operation that happens between the school and the home so that we can work together to ensure that all pupils have the opportunities to fulfil their true potential.



We appreciate very much that a significant group of parents attend the workshop led by Positively MAD recently at the school. This is the second time that the workshop has taken place over the last two years, and it is a very worth-while and interesting event. Jay, the Positively MAD trainer who works with learners, parents and teachers across the country to explain revision planning, strategies and encourage motivation when preparing for examinations explained to the attendees how strategies such as **mind-mapping** and **pegging** may be used effectively to memorise information, and what are the characteristics of effective revision.

Pegging is a method of memorising things very easily. This method requires learners to connect something they wish to learn with a familiar object. An example of this is that countries of the world may be learnt by connecting them with furniture in the bedroom, or with different parts of the body.


This is an example of a mind-map which is focused on creating mind-maps – ask your child for an explanation. Years 8-13 have received Positively MAD training either this year (years 8-10) or two years ago (years 11-13), and mind-maps are also taught to year 7 as part of the Smart Learner course.

Organising the work and revision

Also, Jay from Positively MAD also emphasised several other interesting things in his workshop including:

Sitting up straight – this enables blood and oxygen to flow to the brain, and this makes the learning and memorising process to be much easier for us.

People remember 90% of what we teach to other people, and it is therefore worthwhile to ask your son/daughter to teach you what they have learnt during the previous revising session.

Don't revise when your mobile-phone and Facebook are switched on – trying to revise and use these means that you are wasting 40 minutes. It is much better use of time to revise for 45

minutes, and then to switch the mobile phone and Facebook on during the following break – this should be 15 minutes in length



Learners usually

work more effectively if they are revising in the kitchen or dining room. Younger brothers and sisters should leave the learner alone when he/she is revising, but a parent should be nearby give support e.g. ask questions about the work, and to make sure the internet, X-box, PSP and mobile-phone are being used when this shouldn't happen.

Year 11 questionnaire – revision and examinations

Before the mock-examinations in December, a questionnaire of 15 year 11 pupils was conducted. Some of the answers to the questionnaire were very interesting and support what has been mentioned already when discussing how learners **work at home**:

Several pupils noted that they don't work hard enough at home, and they said the **internet, computer games and mobile phones** attract their attention away from the work. This confirms what Jay from Positively MAD was saying when he noted that it is beneficial for pupils to work under supervision, and not in the bedroom or wherever else they work without a parental eye being kept on what is happening.

Some pupils noted that they **spend too much time with friends** and that they wish their parents would keep them at home for specific revision periods. It is important to have time to relax, but balance is needed, and the time before an examination is an important time for revision.

Most of the boys who were asked, and some of the girls said they wanted their **parents to help them create and manage a revision timetable**.

Some pupils said that **younger brothers and sisters** are disrupting their work, and having peace and quiet to revise is difficult. It was suggested to the pupils who live in town that the town library could be used for revision, and that the school is open until about 6.00 o'clock in the evening and for the majority of the holidays.

Most of the boys and some girls said they would like if their **parents would sit with them when they're revising**, and the parents then test what

has been learnt at the end of the session, and within 2 -3 days to see what information has been retained. Several also said they wished for their parents to discuss with them the process of completing past-papers; this would reinforce what the pupils have learnt in school.

What did the teachers do about the results of the questionnaire?

The results of the questionnaire were also presented to the teachers, and a group of teachers shared their best-practice regarding examination-preparation e.g. recognise the type of answer needed when considering different types of questions, coping with unexpected terminology in the examination, and developing an understanding of command words. Information was also shared about the Quizlet website (<http://quizlet.com/>) which is a website where learners can create and play revision quizzes. Pupils who have already attempted to use this website have enjoyed the work, and they are saying it is a significant help with their revision. All pupils are therefore encouraged to give it a go.

Finally...

In a document produced by the OECD about PISA tests and how parents can help their children succeed in school (<http://www.pisa.oecd.org/dataoecd/4/1/49012097.pdf>), it is noted that pupils are more likely to succeed in examinations when they're 15 years old (GCSEs in Wales), and are more likely to have superior reading skills if the following is happening:



- Parents reading with children, starting at a very young age
- Parents discussing books, films and television programmes with their children
- Parents having a daily discussion about what has been learnt at school on the previous day
- Families eating family meals together around a table
- Children and parents chatting and discussing current political and social issues

The close connection which exists between the school and the home is something we, as a school are proud of. Please remember that each and every parent can contact us at any time to discuss your child's progress, and also to discuss how more support may be provided to ensure future success. **Our aim is to work together to ensure the success of your son/daughter and to ensure that every child in the school has the opportunity to fulfil their potential.**

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

Darllen

During the next few months, along with their usual examinations, year 7, 8 & 9 students will be sitting Literacy and Numeracy exams. These examinations are statutory from this year onwards and it is our intention as a school to prepare the students thoroughly. The literacy exam will last 1 hour.

Reading

It is essential that every pupil makes useful use of their spare time. The school library is full of educational and beneficial reading material for our students to take full advantage. As part of their Welsh and English lessons, pupils will visit the library every fortnight. I ask you as parents/guardians to ensure that each pupil allocates at least half an hour each evening reading – a library book, a newspaper or a suitable magazine. KS3 Terminology Booklet

Every department at the school came together recently to produce a terminology booklet for year 7, 8 & 9 students. These booklets will be dispatched shortly. It is essential that every pupils carries these booklets with them at all times and use them regularly. Year 7, 8 & 9 pupils will receive weekly spelling tests based on these terms.


We hope to host another event after another round of films. This is the place to be for Seeing Stars of the future. Links to all the films are available on the school website.
