

Dear Parents / Carers

I truly hope you and your loved ones are safe and well.

At the beginning of March, less than 1% of pupils across the UK were home educated. As of now, that figure will rise to nearly 100%. Some of you may find the prospect of supporting your child through their home study very exciting, seeing it as a great opportunity to get fully involved in your child's education. However, I am almost certain that many of you will find the prospect rather daunting. Please don't worry! Responsibility for your child's academic progress still rests firmly with your child's teachers. This special edition of our newsletter is all about ensuring you and your child can approach online learning with confidence.

Firstly, it is important that everyone has an "I can" attitude to this type of learning and that everyone is willing to have a go. If you are experiencing problems, then it is important that you contact the school through the help desk link on the school web site – use it if you have difficulty accessing TEAMS or if you haven't got access to a computer. You can also call the school and leave a message on our answer machine.

*If you have difficulty understanding the work, then you can contact the teacher through the Chat function in Teams or email your teacher directly. We will be sending you a guide to help you with working from home; it is also contained in this edition of **Ein Bro**.*

On a separate note, I will be producing a second newsletter later this half term for everyone who was due to sit GCSE, A-level and vocational qualifications this summer. This will further explain the process for awarding grades. At present, schools are waiting to be contacted by vocational course awarding bodies to clarify expectations in this particular area. As always, if there is anything else we can do by way of support; please do not hesitate to ask. Enjoy the online learning challenge!



Adfer Byd Natur ar Afon Ddyfi / Restoring Nature on the River Dyfi

The children were introduced to Beavers and learned where beavers live; what they are doing; how they help other wildlife and why they are no longer here. They then had the opportunity to design and create an ideal beaver habitat.




We know this is a difficult time for everyone, and you as parents/carers have to guide your child through significant changes in learning patterns. We understand this isn't easy. As a result, we offer a few suggestions that could make things a bit easier for you and your child. We suggest that it would be advantageous for you to discuss these with your child.

1) Ensure a working area has been created

Try to provide a specific working area, and that your child has access to the correct equipment. He/she should have a quiet place and time to work with no disruptions. This can be very difficult in a busy home. Is the bedroom or the dining room quiet? Can you be nearby to offer support and check the work when it is completed? Your encouragement and support is very important. Your child will be proud each time


he/she is praised (although remember praise is only valuable if it is deserved). When your child is working, he/she should avoid social media or playing on computer games – these should be rewards for completing a work session. It is a good idea to keep the mobile phone in another room.



2) Ensure your child has the correct equipment to enable him/her to work

3) Set a routine

Your child's teachers are setting work for your child during the Lockdown that will develop and reinforce his/her subject understanding and skills. Work should be submitted by the set deadline. It's a good idea to set a specific routine to normalise and create a focus on the school work your child is asked to complete. We all work more effectively when we follow a routine – mentally as well as physically. We suggest that children work for a set period of time before taking a short break, and then returning to the work afterwards. It is also a good idea to agree on a start time, break-time, lunchtime and when to finish working for the day. Furthermore, we strongly suggest that children start working at the same time every day. It is a good idea to complete a variety of tasks and not to concentrate on one task or subject all the time. Children are not expected to follow the school's current timetable, as this isn't practical. We suggest the following timetables:

Welsh Rainforests Workshop

Ddydd iau 12 Mawrth cafodd dosbarth Helygen gyfle arbennig i gymryd rhan mewn cyfres o weithdai yng ngwarchodfa'r RSPB yn Ynyshir. Dan arweiniad Llinos Alun, Swyddog Ymgysylltu Prosiect Coedwigoedd Glaw Celtaidd Cymru, bu'r disgylion yn dysgu am goedwigoedd glaw gwerthfawr yr ardal a phwysigrwydd eu gwarchod. Cafwyd cyfle i archwilio cynefin y goedwig a'r pwall, a dysgu am gadwyni bwyd. Buont hefyd yn archwilio coed a'u mesur, ynghyd â thrafod pwysigrwydd coed o ran atal effaith cynhesu byd-eang. Yn dilyn y gweithdai hyn, bu'r disgylion yn cydweithio gydag Elin Crowley o gwmni Enny Cymru i greu baner i adlewyrchu pwysigrwydd gofalu am ein coetiroedd. Bu'r disgylion yn meddwl am sloganau bachog er mwyn cyfleo neges glir ar y faner, cyn darlunio planhigion a chreaduriaid y goedwig. Yn dilyn hyn, fe argraffwyd y darluniau a'u peintio ac yna eu hychwanegu i gwbllau'r faner. Diolch i Llinos ac Elin a thîm yr RSPB am gynnig profiadau cyfoethog a gwerth chweil i'r disgylion.



On Thursday 12 March, Helygen class had an opportunity to take part in a series of workshops at the RSPB reserve in Ynyshir. Led by Llinos Alun, Wales Celtic Rainforest Project Engagement Officer, the pupils learned about the area's valuable temperate rainforests and the importance of conserving them. There was an opportunity to explore the forest and pond habitat and learn about food chains. They also examined and measured trees, as well as discussing the importance of trees in preventing the impact of global warming. Following these workshops, pupils worked with Elin Crowley of Enny Cymru to create a banner to reflect the importance of looking after our woodlands. Pupils came up with catchy slogans to convey a clear message on the banner, before sketching the forest's plants and creatures. Following this, the drawings were printed and painted and then added to complete the banner. The school would like to thank Llinos and Elin and the RSPB team for providing the pupils with such enriching and rewarding experiences.



Mrs Jenkins' connection with this tribe began over 40 years ago, so she has a good knowledge of the changes that have taken place in this region of the Amazon Rainforest and the impact of deforestation on the daily life of the Ashaninka people and their environment . The school is very grateful to Mrs Jenkins for sharing her experience.





Useful Websites and Apps for Developing Numeracy Skills

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To further develop the numeracy skills of our pupils, we encourage them to make use of numeracy outside school hours. These are some useful Numeracy websites and Apps that pupils can use to develop their numeracy skills along with what is going on at school.

Bedtime Math

The questions on bedtime math are asked in a written format which requires the pupil to interpret the question and work out the sum needed to answer the question. The questions are differentiated for pupils of lower, medium and high ability learners. The question also changes daily.

Brainist Math Games

The 'Brainist Math Games' is an excellent website for developing mental maths. It includes multiplications, division, addition and subtracting questions. The objective of the game it to answer a series of questions as quickly as possible.

A website that includes a number of revision resources for GCSE Mathematics including '**Who Wants to be a Millionaire?**' - a game that will interest children and develop their numeracy skills.

Motion Math

A useful App for developing numeracy skills as it includes a number of games that are fun for children. The App is focused on developing fractions; they claim that the use of this App improves their fractions by 15% and children's attitude towards mathematics by 10%. Apps are useful for children of 2016 as many of them have access to different ways of using Apps on mobile phones, i-pods and i-pads etc.

Every school aims to develop inquisitive and independent learners. These will be, in the future, the citizens who will be confident to question and reason effectively, and will therefore have developed excellent leadership and problem-solving skills. Many studies show that children, wherever they live, are less likely to ask questions and become less inquisitive as they grow older. After saying that, encouraging children to ask question is very important, and parents as well as the school can make a significant contribution with regards to this.

In the contact book of each pupil in years 7-11 there's a copy of the poster "Questioning Skills". This is a very useful poster to encourage and support learners to develop their questioning skills, and is based on Bloom's Taxonomy (<http://www.nmmu.ac.za/cyberhunts/bloom.htm>). The lower order questions ask for answers which are based on recall - e.g. "How many...?", "What is...?" whereas higher order thinking questions require answers based on application, creativity, analysis and evaluation e.g. "What if...?", "How could...?", "Why would...?". The higher order questions (open) ask for thinking and consideration, whereas the lower order questions (closed) ask for information to be presented. There is value in both types of questions, and we should aim to use both together as often as possible, and also encourage children to ask both types of questions.

As a parent, when your child asks questions, this is something to encourage. Often, the child's independence may be developed by encouraging him/her to seek the answers. This is the age of "Google", and obviously, many answers are to be found on the internet. However, there are also other valuable sources of knowledge – encyclopaedias, library, visit relevant places, asking people to name but a few.

Questions which may encourage discussion and develop thinking skills are questions similar to those asked by Ian Gilbert in his
