### Arrangements for the Start of the New Term

We look forward to welcoming your child back to school in September. Please note that the Education Authority has designated **Tuesday 1 September and Wednesday 2 September** as Preparation days for staff and therefore the school will not be open to children.

#### Attendance

The first two weeks of term will be a period of re-familiarizing with school routines and reintegrating everyone into full-time education. All pupils should be present by **Monday 14th September**.

#### Social Distancing & Hygiene Measures

From September, social distancing measures will be relaxed for primary aged children to enable whole class teaching and for children from more than one class to share the playground and dinner hall.
